**PERMITTED HOURS OF CONSTRUCTION OR REPAIRING OF BUILDINGS:**

Title 11 Chapter 4 Section 11-404(3) l of the City of Franklin Municipal Code **allows** construction, repairing, erection, excavation, demolition, and alteration of buildings during the hours of **7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Monday thru Friday** and then on **Saturday during the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.**.

**PROHIBITED HOURS OF CONSTRUCTION OR REPAIRING OF BUILDINGS:**

Construction, repairing, erection, excavation, demolition, and alteration of buildings is **not allowed** on a **Sunday or a City of Franklin Holiday**.

**City of Franklin Holidays are the following:** New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day.

*Title 11 Chapter 4 Section 11-404(3) i, Construction or repairing of buildings.* The erection (including excavation), construction, demolition, alteration or repair of any building other than between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on weekdays, and from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturdays. Work may also begin on Saturdays at 7:00 a.m. if it would not result in any loud, disturbing, or unnecessary noise that would otherwise violate this chapter. City holidays shall be considered as a Sunday for purposes of this section. If the city administrator or his designee should determine that the interest of the public health and safety are served, by the erection, demolition, alteration or repair of any building or the excavation of streets or highways within the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. and if he shall determine that any loss of inconvenience that might result is outweighed by the public's interest in its safety and welfare, he may grant permission for such work to be done within the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. upon application being made at the time the permit for the work is awarded or during the progress of the work.

Report any complaints after business hours to the Franklin Police Department at (615) 794-2513. This is primarily a 'noise' based ordinance and this code section resides in the 'Offenses Against the Peace and Quiet.' City officials will visit the site to determine if 'noise' is being produced. It is the discretion of the official to issue a citation or to order the activity to cease.
