Excavation/Road Bore Permit Applicant's check list

TENNESSEE

Any excavation in any street, alley, or public place, or any tunnel under any street, alley, or public place, including right-of-way, requires an Excavation/Bore Permit.

Applicant agrees to perform all work relating to the proposed excavation, cut or tunnel in accordance with all laws and ordinances pertaining to such work, including, but not limited to, Title 16-201 through 16-209 (formally Title 12) of the franklin Municipal code. Applicant further agrees to restore the public street or right-of-way to its original condition. In case of unreasonable delay in restoring the public street or right-of-way, the applicant agrees that the City of Franklin, TN may perform the restoration work and charge the expense of the same to applicant, provided the City gives the applicant twenty-four (24) hour notice of its intention to do so.

- 3. Certificate of Liability Insurance, naming City of Franklin, TN as additional insured
- 4. Site Map/sketch

- 6. TOC (Traffic Operations Center) contacted for road closures (48 hours prior) 615-550-6672
- 7. TN1-Call contacted 811
- 8. Franklin Public Works, Water Department contacted 615-794-4554, ext. 6869
- 9. \$100.00 for each excavation/bore
- 10. Upon Completion, call City of Franklin Street Department for Inspection.
