TO PLEAD **NOT GUILTY**

If you wish to PLEAD NOT GUILTY, you must contact the Clerk's office IN ADVANCE of the initial court date listed on your citation in order to be rescheduled for the next CONTESTED court date. If you appear in court without pleading not guilty prior to your Court date, you will be rescheduled for a hearing date where the officer and City Attorney will be present.

COURT EXPECTATIONS

To ensure that each defendant is heard, we request that distractions be minimized. You may be asked to wait outside should you fail to follow these provisions.

- Remove your hat
- Be seated prior to Court
- No food or drink in Court
- Mobile phones off or muted
- No talking during Court
- No shorts or sagging pants

• Stand when the Judge enters

FAILURE TO APPEAR

This is a separate offense, which has no relation to your guilt or innocence with respect to the initial violation. Failure to appear on your scheduled court date will result in an additional fine, state litigation tax, and court cost being levied against you. A collections agent may be used which will result in additional costs and could impact your credit.

The Americans with Disabilities Act prohibits discrimination against any qualified individual with a disability. - If you wish to appear in court and plead *guilty*, you should appear on the date the officer assigned no later than 7:30 a.m.
- If you wish to plead **not guilty**, then follow the instructions on the left side of this page.
- If you wish to pay this citation, you may do so on or before your scheduled court date.
- If your case is litigated (heard) before the Judge and you are found guilty, state litigation taxes will apply.
- Failure to satisfy your citation will result in the TN Dept of Safety being notified to initiate suspension of your driver's license.
