1. Call to Order

Alderman Dana McLendon, Chair, called the meeting to order at 4:01 p.m.

2. Approval of Minutes

Alderman Barnhill moved to approve the September 8, 2011 minutes as presented. Seconded by Alderman Bransford. Motion carried unanimously.

3. Consideration of Property Acquisition/Right-of-Way Abandonment Per the Agreement with Alan D. Revelette and Candace Revelette for the Nichol Mill Lane Project

Eric Gardner explained that several months ago the Revelettes agreed to abandon a portion of the ROW in exchange for giving the City ROW for Nichol Mill.

Alderman Bransford moved to approve Property Acquisition/ROW Abandonment Agreement and forward to BOMA for consideration. Seconded by Alderman Martin. Motion carried unanimously.

4. Consideration of Change Order No. 5 with The Parkes Companies, Inc. for the McEwen Drive Phase III Project (COF Contract No. 2011-0003) for an Increase in the Contract Amount of \$5,800.00 Mr. Gardner explained this was not part of the original contract. These are minor items that required TDOT approval.

Alderman Barnhill moved to approve the increase of \$5,800.00 and forward to BOMA for consideration. Seconded by Alderman Bransford. Motion carried unanimously.

5. Consideration of the Request from The Preserve Subdivision to Install Remove a Stop Sign on Attebury Drive at Bedford Way

Mr. Gardner said the HOA approached the City with this request. Alderman Skinner, Doug Bain of the Preserve Subdivision HOA, and Carl Baughman came forward to address the request.

Mr. Baughman stated the request is to remove a stop sign that is at an abandoned road. There was a long-term plan for it to become a T-intersection, but that evidently is not going to happen in the foreseeable future. Staff recommends the removal of the stop sign and replace it with a Right Turn warning sign (As this bend is a sharp right-angle turn the elimination of the Right Turn sign is not an option). Also, mark the centerline outline of the turns at the entry median. This option will require an Ordinance for the removal of the Stop Sign.

Alderman Bransford moved to approve Staff recommendation and make the associated traffic control improvements upon adoption of an Ordinance to remove Stop control on Attebury Drive at Bedford Way, and forward to BOMA for consideration. Seconded by Alderman Barnhill. Motion carried unanimously.

6. Consideration of the Request for Water Availability for 1122 Warrior Drive

The property is in the unincorporated County (Leeland Subdivision). Warrior Drive has an existing waterline and the property owner would like to tap on to that and build on the property. They are within the City water service boundaries.

Alderman Martin moved to approve request for Water Availability and forward to BOMA for consideration. Seconded by Alderman Barnhill. Motion carried unanimously.
