SUBJECT: Consider rejecting all bids for replacement of three (3) rescue chassis and associated work for the Fire Department (Purchasing Office Procurement Solicitation No. 2012-020)

Purpose

The purpose of this procurement was to have been (a) the supply and delivery of a quantity of three (3) new cab and chassis, (b) the removal of a quantity of three (3) existing rescue bodies and sundry equipment from three (3) existing cab and chassis and mounting the bodies and sundry equipment on the new cab and chassis, (c) net of any trade-in for the existing cab and chassis. The new cab and chassis would replace existing cab and chassis that are scheduled this current fiscal year to be removed from service.

Background

The City published on January 26, 2012 a Notice to Bidders in the *Williamson Herald* for the supply and delivery of a quantity of three (3) new cab and chassis, including the removal of a quantity of three (3) existing rescue bodies and sundry equipment from three (3) existing cab and chassis and mounting the bodies and sundry equipment on the new cab and chassis, net of any trade-in for the existing cab and chassis. In addition, bid documents were sent on or about the same date directly to eleven (11) potential bidders known or thought to be interested in this solicitation. Even though five (5) vendors complied with the requirement to schedule and attend a mandatory pre-bid appointment, the City received only one (1) bid. This bid was publicly opened at the bid opening held on February 23, 2012. A tabulation of the bids received for this solicitation is attached.

Financial Impact

The sole bid received is in the total amount of \$464,079.00 for the specified procurement. For the three (3) rescue vehicles, this amount averages \$154,693.00 each. This average pricing per each rescue vehicle, which includes the existing rescue bodies, compares with an expectation that the purchase price of an entirely new rescue vehicle, including not only a new cab and chassis but also a new rescue body, of roughly the same amount.

Options

In accordance with the bid documents, the City reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Recommendation

Staff observes that the sole bid received took 27 exceptions to City specifications. Due to the exceptions taken, as well as the pricing relative to the expected purchase price of an entirely new rescue vehicle, staff recommends that the City reject the only bid and consider its options. Purchasing Manager Brian Wilcox is of the opinion that the prepared specifications as distributed allowed for competition among multiple vendors, and that the staff recommendation appears to be made in a fair and impartial manner based upon the bids received.
