Status of Connections to the City of Franklin's Sanitary Sewer System for

Properties in the Sewer Assessment Districts

## Purpose

The purpose of this item is to provide a status of actions by property owners to connect to the sanitary sewer system for the five Sewer Assessment Districts.

# Background

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen has approved five (5) Sewer Assessment Districts which allowed the City to extend its current wastewater collection system to homes which had requested access to service. Assessments were made to allow the City to recoup its investment. Property owners could pay their share of the costs over time with monthly payments or could pay the amount in full at any time without penalty.

Property owners did not have to connect to the sanitary sewer system. However, if they chose to, they would pay the applicable tap fees established for that district. Owners are responsible for the onsite costs of connection.

# **Impact**

We have seen success as measured by connection to the sanitary sewer collection system. We now have about 25% of the properties connected to the city's sanitary sewer system. Additionally, about 42% of the properties owners have paid their assessment in full.

A summary of actions by district is shown on the attached.

### Recommendation

Staff recommends acceptance of this update.
