**CALL TO ORDER**

Alderman Clyde Barnhill, Chair, called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

**1. Approval of Minutes**

*Alderman Burger moved to approve the February 14, 2012 minutes as presented. Seconded by Alderman Barnhill. Motion carried unanimously.*

**2. Consider Application of Franklin Tomorrow d/b/a Raise the Roofs, 239 Franklin Road (Harlinsdale Farm), June 16, 2012, 3:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m., Mindy Tate, Managing Agent, for Special Event, On Premises Consumption**

Mindy Tate explained the event is to raise money to replace the roofs on the main barn and the Hayes home at Harlinsdale.

*Alderman Burger moved to approve Special Event Beer Permit, On Premises Consumption. Seconded by Alderman Barnhill. Motion carried unanimously.*

**3. Consider Application of Joseph Bader d/b/a Papa Boudreaux's Cajun Café, 328 Main Street, Joseph Bader, Managing Agent, for On Premises Consumption**

Joseph Bader was present. There was discussion on the third bullet point of their Safe Alcohol Consumption Policy: "We will be selling beer by the bottle at the café. No employee is to open or pour any type of alcohol at any time. The servers will bring it to the table, with the cap on, and the patrons must open it themselves." Mr. Bader noted it is corporate policy. Their other location is in a county to which this stipulation applies. It was suggested the statement be deleted from the policy for the Franklin Beer Permit.

*Alderman Burger moved to approve Beer Permit for On Premises Consumption. Seconded by Alderman Barnhill.*

Steve Sims noted a temporary permit had been issued. Mr. Bader submitted his initial application in December and was unable to attend the January and February Beer Board meetings. During that time the corporate structure changed and the applicant should be shown as GoThom, LLC. Mr. Sims recommended a revised application be submitted to align all documents. Kristen Corn concurred.

*Motion to approve Beer Permit for On Premises Consumption for GoThom, LLC carried unanimously.*

**4. Consider Application of Franklin Pizza company d/b/a Marco's Pizza, 4115 Mallory Lane, Suite 212, Stuart Field, Managing Agent, for On Premises Consumption**

Stuart Field was present and said they have been in operation since May, but in November they took over the space next door to add seating. Mr. Sims noted the permit would be held until issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy.

*Alderman Burger moved to approve issuance of Beer Permit for On Premises Consumption pending receipt of Certificate of Occupancy. Motion carried unanimously.*

**5. Other Business**

Special Meeting:

A special meeting must be scheduled for a violation that occurred in September 2011 at La Palmas. Ms. Corn will advise open dates during the first two weeks of April.

Main Street Festival:

Mr. Sims noted the dates for the Main Street Festival did not align with the dates that were approved and recorded in the minutes. Committee members resigned a permit reflecting the correct dates of April 28 and April 29, 2012.
