CALL TO ORDER

Alderman Clyde Barnhill, Chair, called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

1. Approval of Minutes

Alderman Burger moved to approve the January 10, 2012 minutes as presented. Seconded by Alderman Bransford. Motion carried unanimously.

2. Consider Application of Joseph Bader d/b/a Papa Boudreaux's Cajun Café, 328 Main Street, Joseph Bader, Managing Agent, for On Premises Consumption

Applicant was not present.

3. Consider Application of Charun Chungaew d/b/a Basil Bistro, 9040 Carothers Parkway, Suite A-201, Charun Chungaew, Managing Agent, for On Premises Consumption

Charun Chungaew was present. Change of ownership. Same staff.

Alderman Burger moved to approve Beer Permit for On Premises Consumption. Seconded by Alderman Bransford. Motion carries unanimously.

4. Consider Application of Joe Allen King d/b/a Smok N Joe's Market & Deli, 1182 West Main Street, Joe Allen King, Managing Agent, for Off Premises Consumption

Joe Allen King was present. Formerly West Main Street Market. Family business.

Alderman Bransford moved to approve Beer Permit for Off Premises Consumption. Seconded by Alderman Burger. Motion carried unanimously.

5. Consider Application of JNH, Inc. d/b/a Wild Wing Café, 545 Cool Springs Boulevard, Suite 195, Jason Hedge, Managing Agent, for On Premises Consumption

Jason Hedge was present. New business. Anticipate opening in mid-April. Steve Sims noted the Permit should be approved pending applicant's receipt of Certificate of Occupancy.

Alderman Burger moved to approve Beer Permit for On Premises Consumption pending issuance of Certificate of Occupancy. Seconded by Alderman Bransford. Motion carried unanimously.

6. **Consider Application of Armondo Lomeli d/b/a West Coast Burrito, 625 Baker's Bridge Avenue, Suite 100, Armondo Lomeli, Managing Agent, for On Premises Consumption**
Armondo Lomeli was present. This is a new business. Training procedure in order. Steve Sims noted the Permit should be approved pending applicant's receipt of Certificate of Occupancy.

Alderman Burger moved to approve Beer Permit for On Premises Consumption pending issuance of Certificate of Occupancy. Seconded by Alderman Bransford. Motion carried unanimously.

7. **Consider Application Virat Trachukul d/b/a Thai Spice Sushi & Thai Dishes, 1031 Riverside Drive, Suite G, Virat Trachukul, Managing Agent, for On Premises Consumption**
Virat Trachukul was present. New ownership. Staff retained.

Alderman Burger moved to approve Beer Permit for On Premises Consumption. Seconded by Alderman Bransford. Motion carried unanimously.

8. **Consider Application of TriStar Energy, LLC d/b/a Twicedaily #8815, 222 West New Highway 96, Michael Rogers, Managing Agent, for Off Premises Consumption**
Michael Rogers was present. Name change. Same staff.

Alderman Bransford moved to approve Beer Permit for Off Premises Consumption. Seconded by Alderman Burger. Motion carried unanimously.

9. **Consider Application of Heritage Foundation/Downtown Franklin Association d/b/a Franklin Main Street Brew Fest, Main Street between Second and Fifth Avenues, Event Date and Hours: March 17, 2012, 6:00 PM until 9:00 PM, Nancy Williams, Managing Agent, for Special Event, On Premises Consumption**
Nancy Williams was present along with Natasha Hendrix of McCreary's Irish Pub.

Ms. Williams indicated there are minor changes due to changes in the businesses participating in the event (refer to map and list of sites on the following pages). Chief Rahinsky noted the entire area shown on the map between Second Avenue and Fifth Avenue along Main Street and the side streets will be cordoned off as indicated on the map. Beer will only be served to ticket holders who have their IDs checked by professional security between the event hours of 6-9 PM.

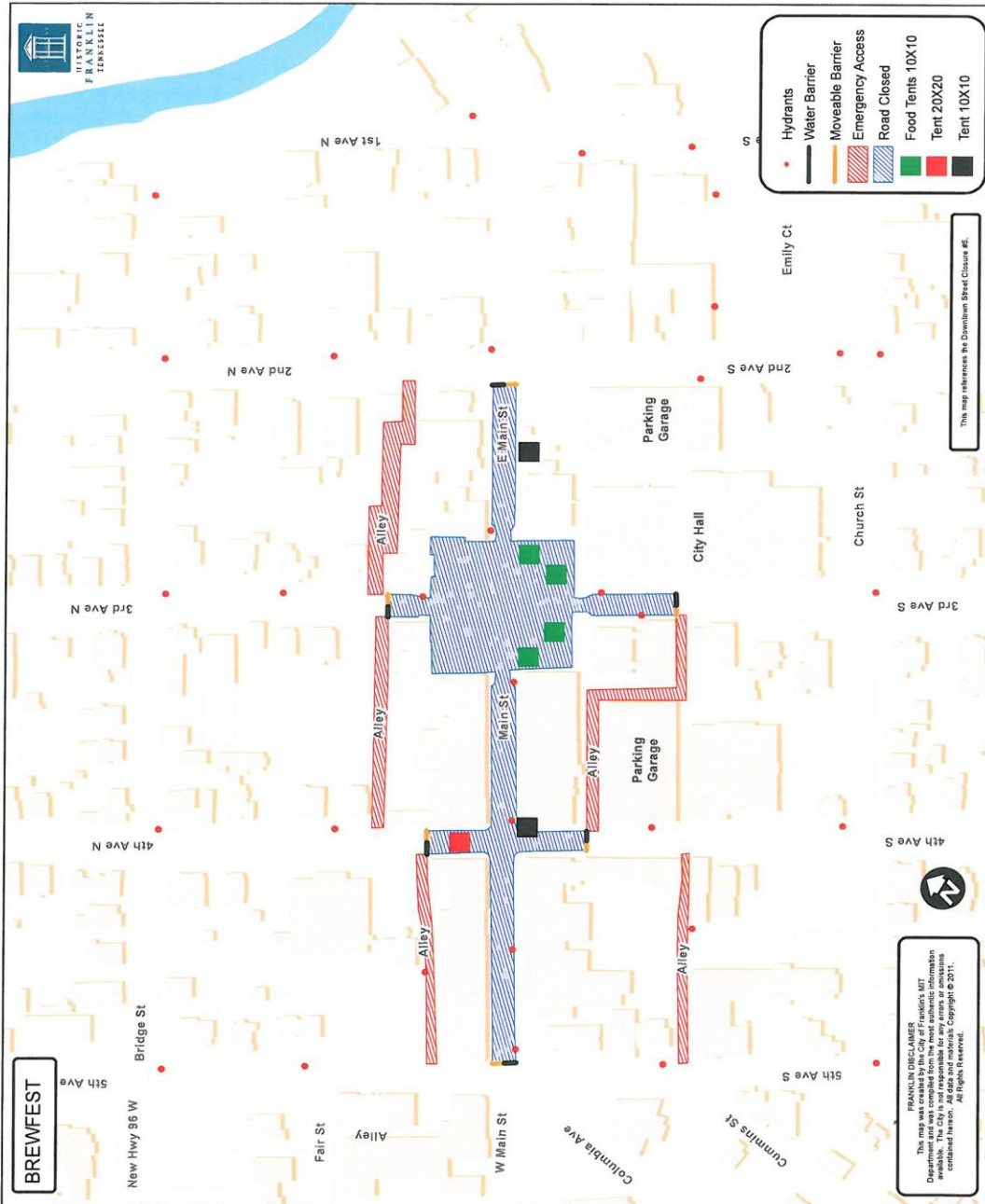
Alderman Burger moved to approve Beer Permit for Special Event, On Premises Consumption. Seconded by Alderman Bransford.

During the ensuing discussion, additional clarity was sought and provided regarding McCreary's serving beer outside the parameters of their Sidewalk Permit and into the event area. The applicant intended for the application to cover this. Steve Sims said the exception was not clearly stated in the application. Per the application, businesses were to dispense beer in the event containers at their establishment and patrons would be allowed to roam around in the permitted event area. During the ensuing discussion it was determined to be acceptable for event patrons at McCreary's to use the McCreary's

containers in lieu of the event containers within the permitted area. Due to space limitations, certain establishments will dispense in front of their establishment for the event patrons as indicated on the participant list.

Alderman Barnhill commented this seems to come up every year for clarification.

Motion to approve Special Event Permit carried unanimously.

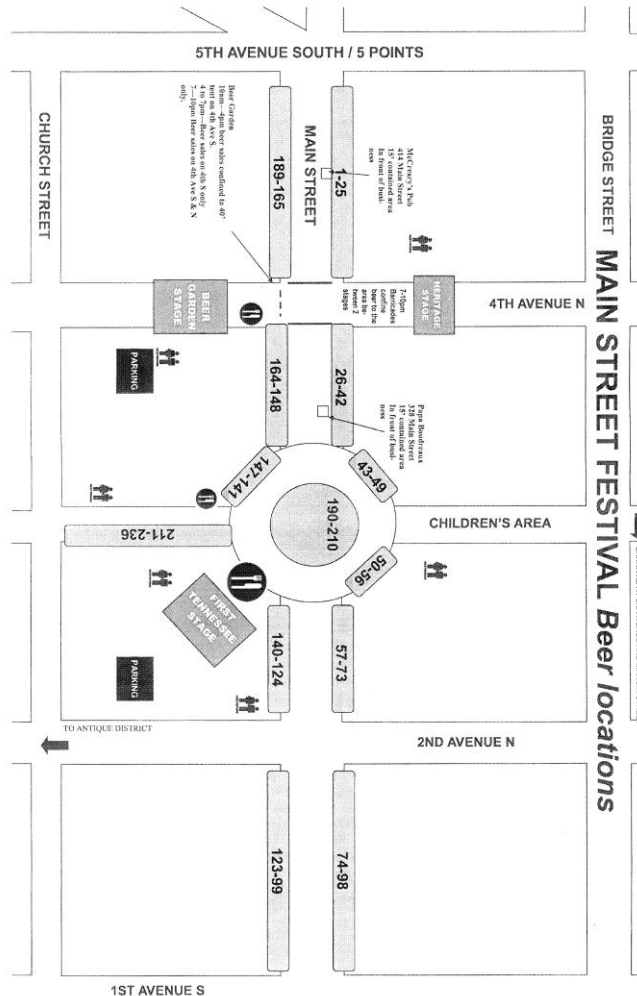

10. Consider Application of Heritage Foundation/Downtown Franklin Association d/b/a Franklin Main Street Festival, Fourth Avenue, 414 Main Street (McCreary's), and 328 Main Street (Papa Boudreaux's), Event Date and Hours: April 28, 2012, 10:00 AM until 10:00 PM., April 29, 2012, Noon until 6:00 PM, Nancy Williams, Managing Agent, for Special Event, On Premises Consumption

Per memo from Ms. Williams submitted to the Beer Board:

- a. The normal beer tent location at 4th Avenue South in front of the parking garage. The tent is much smaller this year (40' instead of 100') to make room for more food vendors for the general public. Throughout the day, until 4 p.m., beer would be confined to this tent. At 4 p.m., we propose allowing beer in the 4th Avenue South food court with a barricade at Main Street shown by the dotted line on the map. Private security will contain the beer at this point. At 7 p.m., barricades would move to Main Street to contain the beer to 4th Avenue North and South until 10 p.m., when the event closes.
- b. 414 Main Street in an enclosure in front of McCreary's Pub, same as the last several years.
- c. 328 Main Street in an enclosure in front of Papa Boudreaux, in the same arrangement as McCreary's just for a newer business. Both businesses will serve in non-breakable containers and will contain their customers to their areas.

Alderman Bransford moved to approve Special Event Beer Permit for On Premises Consumption. Seconded by Alderman Burger. Motion carried unanimously.
