SUBJECT:

Consideration of contract award to Automated Collection Services, Inc. of Nashville, TN for bad debt collection services, for an initial term of service of three (3) years, effective upon acceptance by the City, with two (2) options to extend the term of service, each time by mutual consent of both parties and for up to one (1) additional year, for a maximum possible term of service of five (5) years total (Purchasing Office Procurement Solicitation No. 2012-021; \$4,000 budgeted in 110-82599-41200 (Court) and \$4,000 budgeted in 110-82599-41310 (Revenue Management) for

fiscal year 2012; Contract No. 2012-0071)

Purpose

The purpose of this procurement is to purchase bad debt collection services for a variety of types of indebtedness to the City including, but not limited to: utility service bills, other user fees, court fees and fines, assessments, taxes (very limited), permits and licenses, all as identified by the City and transferred from the City to the vendor for collections. In addition, payments made to the City using checks or other negotiable instruments that are returned as "NSF" or other annotation indicating that the presenter did not honor the instrument will be forwarded to the selected proposer for collection.

Background

The City published on February 9, 2012 a Notice to Proposers in the Williamson Herald for bad debt collection services. In addition, solicitation documents were sent on or about the same date directly to 26 potential proposers known or thought to be interested in this solicitation. Proposals from seven (7) vendors were publicly opened at the proposal opening held on March 15, 2012. A tabulation of the proposals received for this solicitation is attached. A proposal evaluation team (consisting of the Assistant City Recorder and City Court Clerk, the Interim Assistant City Recorder, and the City's Comptroller) scored each of the proposals using the evaluation criteria listed in the request for proposals. The tabulation indicates the averages of the points allocated by the proposal evaluation team. The proposal evaluation team also interviewed the two firms scored highest. The proposal ranked highest by the proposal evaluation team is from Automated Collection Services, Inc. of Nashville, TN.

Financial Impact

Inasmuch as the fee quoted by Automated Collection Services, Inc. is a contingency fee (at the rate of 20% for all types of indebtedness other than litigation accounts), the City would incur no adverse financial impact by retaining that firm for bad debt collection services. The City could choose to compensate the vendor by means of issuing payment as is customary for most other services rendered to and for the City. Alternatively, the City could choose to compensate the vendor by authorizing the vendor to deduct its fee from the amount collected by the vendor and remitted to the City.

Options

In accordance with the solicitation documents, the City reserves the right to reject any and all proposals.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City accept the proposal ranked highest by the proposal evaluation team, from Automated Collection Services, Inc. of Nashville, TN, for bad debt collection services. Purchasing Manager Brian Wilcox is of the opinion that the prepared solicitation documents as distributed allowed for competition among multiple vendors, and that the staff recommendation appears to be made in a fair and impartial manner based upon the proposals received.
