## **ORDINANCE 2012-31**

## TO BE ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A TWO-WAY STOP SIGN CONTROL AT THE INTERSECTION OF MCEWEN DRIVE AND OXFORD GLEN DRIVE"

WHEREAS, an engineering study has been conducted that indicates a basis for the twoway stop control imposed herein, and

WHEREAS, the existing intersection named above provides for stop control in all four (4) directions (McEwen Drive and Oxford Glen Drive); and

**WHEREAS,** the Capital Investment Committee unanimously approved the request to remove the stop control on Oxford Glen Drive at this intersection on May 10, 2012.

## **NOW THEREFORE:**

**SECTION I: BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that motor vehicles traveling on Oxford Glen Drive approaching McEwen Drive shall be exempt from the requirement to come to a complete stop.

**SECTION II: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that motor vehicles traveling McEwen Drive approaching Oxford Glen Drive shall be required to come to a complete stop before entering the intersection, and remain standing until such motor vehicles can proceed through the intersection safely.

SECTION III: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, the Director of the Streets Department shall be, and is hereby, authorized to install the proper signs to notify the general public of this revision.

**SECTION IV: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that all violations of the Ordinance shall be enforced in accordance with Title 15 of the Franklin Municipal Code or in accordance with any pertinent provisions of the Tennessee Code Annotated

**SECTION V: BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED** by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage on second reading, the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens requiring it.
