SUBJECT: Resolution 2012-38, A Resolution to Support Issuance of a Battle of Franklin U.S. Postage Stamp

Purpose

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide the Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) with information regarding the Battlefield Preservation Commission's recommendation to support the issuance of a commemorative Battle of Franklin U.S. postage stamp.

Background

The Tennessee Civil War National Heritage Area (TCWNHA) and Franklin's Charge Inc. made application to the United States Postal Service and the Citizens Stamp Advisory Committee for the issuance of a U.S. postage stamp to be issued on November 30, 2014 commemorating the 150th Anniversary of the 1864 Battle of Franklin.

The Franklin Battlefield Preservation Commission recommends endorsement of a resolution by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee to fully support the efforts of the TCWNHA and Franklin's Charge to obtain issuance of a commemorative Battle of Franklin U.S. postage stamp, as such issuance would be a well-deserved tribute to this important historic event in American history.
