A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN FOR THE CITY OF FRANKLIN TO AMEND RESOLUTION 2011-32 ADOPTING AN ESTIMATE OF REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE WATER AND SEWER UTILITY FUND, FISCAL YEAR 2011 – 2012 AND FISCAL YEAR 2012-2013

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin owns and operates a water and sanitary sewer utility system under authorization of the Municipal Charter, and

WHEREAS, this Utility Fund is an enterprise fund of the City in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, and

WHEREAS, it is now deemed in the public interest to provide for authorization of an estimate of revenues and expenditures for such fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Franklin as follows:

Section 1. That the Amendment to the Statement of Estimated Revenues and Expenditures for the Water and Sewer Utility Fund, for Fiscal Year 2012-2013, as set forth more fully in **Attachment A**, is herewith approved and adopted and does allocate and appropriate additional funding as follows:

Purpose

The purpose of this item is to amend the second year of the 2012 & 2013 Water Management Budget to account for activities or conditions arising since passage of the original budget.

Background

Rather than bringing a new 2013 budget to the Committee and Board, these amendments reflect those items that have arisen since passage of the budget during the 2012 budget process.
