SUBJECT: Contract Award for Construction of S.R. 96W at Boyd Mill Avenue & Carlisle Lane Intersection Improvements  
(COF Contract 2012-0148)

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide the Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) the tabulated bid results for the S.R. 96W at Boyd Mill Avenue and Carlisle Lane Intersection Improvements and to present a recommendation for contract.

### **Background**

The S.R. 96W at Boyd Mill Avenue and Carlisle Lane Intersection Improvements Project generally consists of the following items:

- Widening of S.R. 96W intersection approaches to Boyd Mill Avenue & Carlisle Lane from 2 lanes to 5 lanes,
- Widening of Boyd Mill Avenue & Carlisle Lane intersection approaches to S.R. 96W from 2 lanes to 3 lanes,
- Alignment adjustment of Boyd Mill Avenue & Carlisle Lane intersection approaches,
- Installation of traffic signal, including pedestrian crossing signals.

On October 19, 2012 the City of Franklin and Neel-Schaffer opened construction bids for the S.R. 96W at Boyd Mill Avenue & Carlisle Lane Intersection Improvements Project. The apparent low bidder was Highways, Inc. A summary of the bid results by Neel-Schaffer is included for your review.

### **Financial Impact**

The apparent low bidder is Highways, Inc. with a total construction contract price of \$2,166,454.75. This project is entirely City funded via the Capital Projects Fund.

### **Recommendation**

Staff recommends approval of this construction contract with Highways, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$2,166,454.75.

Six responsive bids were opened and read aloud for the above-referenced project on Thursday, October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2012, at 1:00 p.m. A summary of the bid results is shown in the table below:

Each bid was evaluated and found acceptable based on the requirements of the Instruction to Bidders in the Project Manual. Therefore, we recommend that the award of contract for the construction of the above referenced project to the low bidder, **Highways, Inc.**, in the amount of **\$2,166,454.75**.
