SUBJECT: Follow-up Survey of 11th Avenue South Property Owners
Report for BOMA Workshop on January 26, 2010

Purpose

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide information to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) regarding a follow-up survey of property owners concerning the BOMA-approved No Parking regulation on the west side of the street.

Background

Based on an Engineering Department recommendation that followed a citizen petition, BOMA approved Ordinance 2009-59 on October 13, 2009 removing parking from 11th Avenue South between Natchez and West Main. Following some additional concerns raised by neighborhood residents (including other petitions supporting restoration of parking on one side of the street), staff was asked to conduct an additional survey of residents regarding the removal of parking from 11th Avenue South between Natchez and West Main Street. In addition to the survey, a neighborhood meeting was conducted by Third Ward Alderman Mike Skinner and Vice Mayor Pearl Bransford.

Data

The results of the Engineering-conducted petition are summarized below:

Only residents on 11th Avenue South between Natchez and West Main were surveyed. Included in this group were the condominiums off of 11th Avenue South. Of this group three votes were received, two in favor of the removal of parking and one against.

These results appear to confirm the initial citizen-initiated petition and provide a basis for implementing the approved Ordinance. The attached map gives the breakdown of the property responses and non-responses.

For traffic engineering purposes, the Ordinance should be implemented for the following reasons:

- 11th Avenue is classified as a Major Collector street on the City's Major Thoroughfare Plan (MTP).
- The pavement width is a narrow 20 feet, with no centerline striping.
- Parking is already prohibited on the east side of the street, thus shifting it to the west side of the street.
- Allowing parking on the west side creates a Yield street, in conflict with the MTP designation.
- Establishes clear travel lanes in both directions for general traffic and emergency response including nearby Fire Station #1.

Options

The result of the investigations is two options for parking control treatments on this street. These are listed below:

- Option 1 - Confirm the previous decision to remove parking from this section of 11th Avenue South. As a result "No On-Street Parking" signs (eight total) would be installed. Four of these would upgrade the "No Parking This Side of Street" signs on the east side of the street, and the other four would initiate the regulation on the west side of the street. Also install a single yellow dashed centerline to designate travel lanes and the thoroughfare status of this street.
- Option 2 - Rescind BOMA's October 2009 action and reestablish this section of 11th Avenue South as no parking on one side of the street.

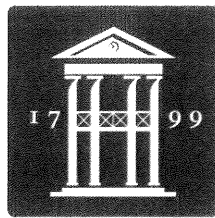
Financial Impact

Minimal labor and equipment costs (performed by Streets Department) related to the installation of signs.

Recommendation

Based on the recent petition of residents on 11th Avenue South between Natchez and West Main and the Engineering Department's recommendation, it is recommended that BOMA confirm their previous action to establish 11th Avenue South between Natchez and West Main as a no parking area.

Dear Homeowner near 11th Avenue South,

This letter follows the December 1, 2009 survey of neighborhood input regarding the new parking prohibition on the west side of 11th Avenue South between West Main Street and Natchez Street. It also follows up on the neighborhood meeting called by Alderman Michael Skinner that was held on Saturday December 5, 2009. Alderman Skinner, Vice Mayor Pearl Bransford and Traffic Engineer Carl Baughman thank you for your participation in these activities. The chart below gives the tabulation from the survey ballots.

The survey has been useful to gauge neighborhood opinion on this issue, and we thank you for your participation. It results in a 69% substantial majority of Yes votes from the returned ballots, and even a 52% majority of the property owners who received their letters whether they responded or not. At the neighborhood meeting, there was concern expressed over including the “11th off Main” property owners in the survey. There were a total of three responses from those condominiums, two yes votes and one no vote, which basically follows the overall pattern. Therefore we have a general neighborhood consensus in agreement with Ordinance 2009-59, “An Ordinance to Establish a No Parking Zone on a Portion of 11th Avenue South” as approved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) on October 13, 2009.

The Engineering and Street Departments consider this finding sufficient to proceed with the posting of the approved regulation. There will be approximately four (4) signs installed along the west side of the

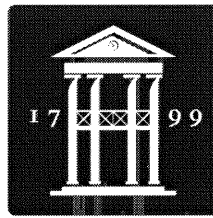
street indicating “No On-Street Parking”. The existing signs on the east side of the street will be upgraded in the same manner now that both sides of 11th Avenue South are consistently regulated. The effect of this posting is that any vehicle with overhang of the 11th Avenue South traveled way would be subject to ticketing by the Franklin Police Department. The installation schedule for the signs is subject to the ongoing activities of the Street Department. In addition, the Street Department will stripe the centerline of 11th Avenue South with a single yellow dashed line for lane designation and thoroughfare street treatment.

Consideration of installing these traffic control devices is to be discussed at the January Workshop meeting of BOMA that will occur on Tuesday January 26, 2010 in the City Hall Boardroom at 5 p.m. This meeting is open to the public and is available for your participation.

Again, the Engineering Department thanks you for your participation in the survey and attendance at the December 5 neighborhood meeting. The survey has been useful to gauge neighborhood opinion on this issue, and we thank you for your participation. It results in a 72% substantial majority of Yes votes from the returned ballots, and even a 56% majority of the property owners who received their letters whether they responded or not. Therefore we have a general neighborhood consensus in agreement with Ordinance 2009-59, "An Ordinance to Establish a No Parking Zone on a Portion of 11th Avenue South" as approved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on October 13, 2009.

The Engineering and Street Departments consider this finding sufficient to proceed with the posting of the approved regulation. There will be approximately four (4) signs installed along the west side of the street indicating "No Parking on Pavement". The existing signs on the east side of the street will be upgraded to a similar pattern now that both sides of 11th Avenue South are consistently regulated. The

SUBJECT: **Parking Restriction - 11th Avenue South between West Main Street and Natchez Street**

At the last Board of Mayor and Aldermen meeting (October 13th), the Board acted to prohibit on-street parking at all times on both sides of the street on 11th Avenue South between West Main Street and Natchez Street. This action was triggered by a petition of a property owner in the area. The City has since received a petition from another resident seeking to restore parking to the west side of the street on this section of 11th Avenue South. Attached you will find a memo from Traffic/Transportation Engineer Carl Baughman explaining the process and situation. Also provided is the original petition, map, and the petition seeking to restore parking in the area.

I have placed this item on November 10th BOMA work session for discussion and guidance from the Board.

Investigation and Petition Process

DATE: October 26, 2009

My recommendation memo of August 26, 2009 referenced a petition form and map as attachments to that memo. It seems that these did not make the BOMA packet, and for that please accept my apologies. In fact, earlier today I emailed these to Alderman Michael Skinner in response to his request for these documents. I have them attached to this memo, with the following description of their development and review.

When Mr. Floyd Beech requested that the City install No Parking signs on the west side of 11th Avenue South, I directed him to collect signatures on a petition in order to gauge the desires of property owners along 11th Avenue South. That way the directly affected property owners would be represented in the petition. Using our Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program process as the only available precedent for petitions, I applied the 51% majority representation criterion for the subject petition. On July 24, 2009 Mr. Beech submitted his initial petition, which upon checking did not meet the 51% majority representation criterion. A copy of that petition is attached to this memo. I directed him to obtain additional signatures and on August 6, 2009 his second petition as attached provided the necessary representation.

For clarification on the meaning of this Ordinance, it is intended to provide a continuously clear travelled way for the single lane of available pavement in the southbound direction. That is, parking may occur on paved surfaces outside of the travelled way as long as that parking does not obstruct the passage of vehicles and pedestrians. Another factor that would clarify the travelled way would be a double yellow center line, as requested today by Mr. Beech. This is already marked north of Main Street, and seems appropriate for the unmarked portion of 11th Avenue south of Main Street. Joe York and I plan to check field locations for the signing at 10 a.m. on Tuesday October 27, 2009, and also discuss the striping.

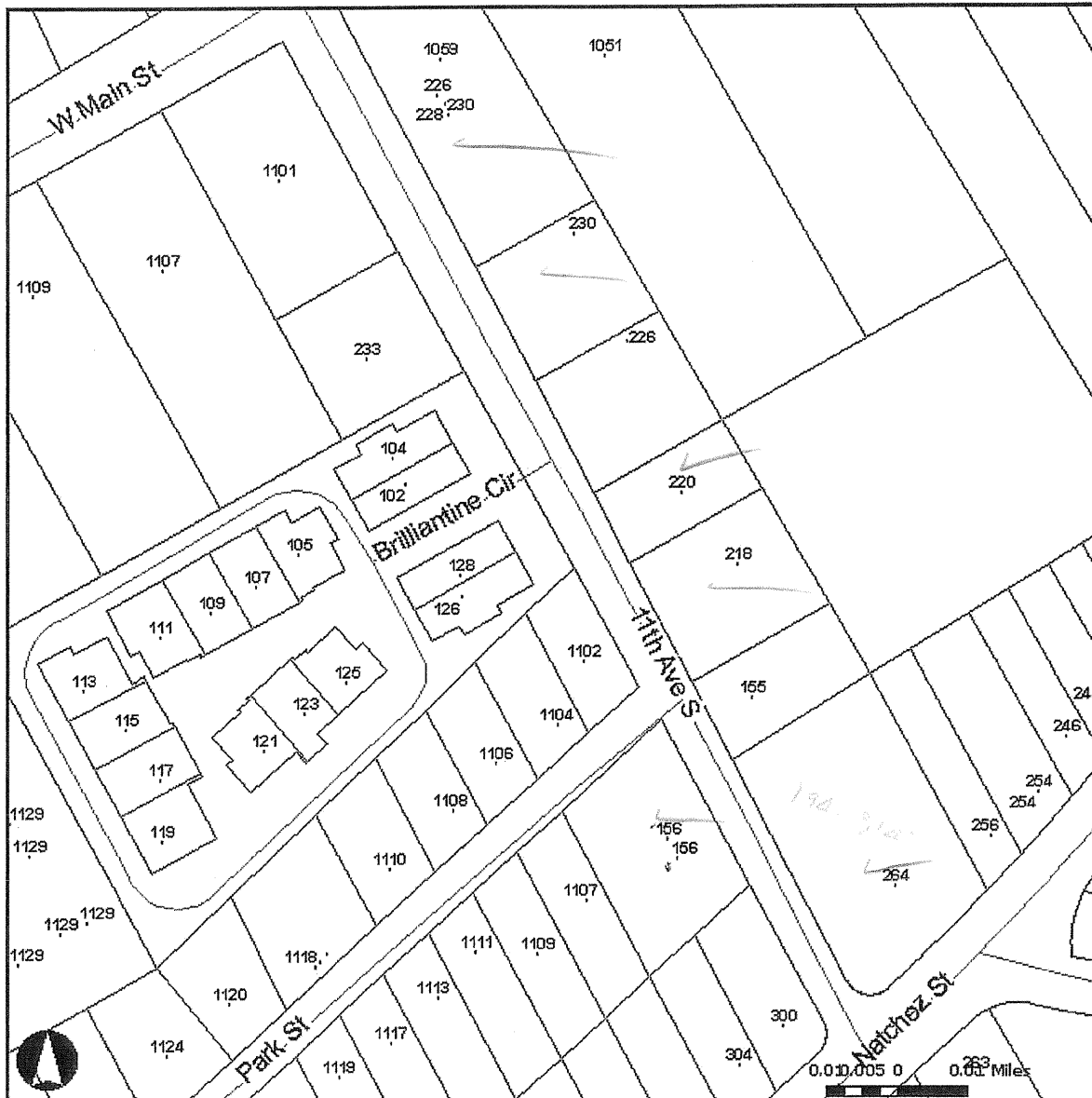

ORDINANCE 2009-59

TO BE ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A NO PARKING ZONE ON A PORTION OF 11TH AVENUE SOUTH IN THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE."

WHEREAS, 11th Avenue South between West Main Street and Natchez Street is designated as a Major Collector Street in the City's Thoroughfare Plan, and

WHEREAS, this portion of 11th Avenue South currently has a No Parking zone on the east side of the street, and

WHEREAS, a majority of property owners fronting this portion of 11th Avenue South have presented a petition to establish a No Parking zone on the west side of the street, and

WHEREAS, the narrow 20 feet wide street should be clear of parking to facilitate general traffic and traffic related access to the nearby Fire Station #1,

NOW THEREFORE:

SECTION I: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, that on-street parking shall be prohibited at all times on both sides of 11th Avenue South between West Main Street and Natchez Street.

SECTION II: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, Tennessee, that the Streets Department Director or his Designee shall be, and is hereby authorized to obtain and install all necessary signs and/or other signalization to carry out the intention of this Ordinance.


SECTION III: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, Tennessee, that the penalty for failure to obey the provisions of this Ordinance shall be as indicated in the Franklin Municipal Code and/or the Tennessee Code Annotated.

SECTION IV: BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, Tennessee, that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage on second and final reading, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Franklin requiring it.

SUBJECT: Establish No Parking Zone on the west side of 11th Avenue South
Between West Main Street and Natchez Street

Purpose

The purpose of this memo is to bring forward a request to establish a no parking zone on 11th Avenue South.

Background

Eleventh Avenue South has seen recent increases in residential and business development which have translated into new demand for parking. Parking is currently prohibited on the east side of the street, but the development has occurred mostly on the west side of the street which does not have a prohibition on parking. With this Major Collector Street being only 20 feet wide, it is highly advisable that both sides carry the parking prohibition. Mr. Floyd Beech of 220 11th Avenue south requested that the west side also have a prohibition on parking. In order to gauge the sense of the neighborhood, Mr. Beech was directed to petition both sides of the street for property owners who would agree to the change. The result is 58% of present property owners in agreement with the proposal. Therefore I offer the attached draft of an ordinance to provide for that designation. Attached are the petition and a map showing the representation.

Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of establishing the no parking zone on 11th Avenue between West Main Street and Natchez Street.
