Consideration of bid award to Sherwin-Williams Paint Co. of Franklin, TN in the total amount of \$48,672.78 for purchase of one (1) trailered roadway paint marking system for the Traffic Division of the Streets Department (Purchasing Office Procurement Solicitation No. 2013-009; \$45,000 budgeted in 110-89530-43110 for fiscal year 2013; purchase to be allocated to 110-

89520-43110; Contract No. 2013-0017)

Purpose

The purpose of this procurement is to purchase one (1) new trailered roadway paint marking system. This equipment would be used to apply roadway traffic paint and reflective beads for such needs as lane striping and intersection crosswalks and directional arrows. The new equipment would replace a 1999-model trailered roadway paint marking system that is scheduled this current fiscal year to be removed from service.

Background

The City published on January 31, 2013 a Notice to Bidders in the *Williamson Herald* for a minimum of one (1) new trailered roadway paint marking system. In addition, bid documents were sent on or about the same date directly to three (3) potential bidders known or thought to be interested in this solicitation. Bids from four (4) vendors were publicly opened at the bid opening held on February 14, 2013. A tabulation of the bids received for this solicitation is attached.

Financial Impact

The apparent lowest, most responsive and responsible bid, from Sherwin-Williams Paint Co. of Franklin, is in the amount of \$48,672.78 for the specified trailered roadway paint marking system. This bid was identified because it is the lowest bid that most closely meets or exceeds the City's intention as expressed and implied by the City's specifications as well as the instructions, terms and conditions pertaining to this procurement solicitation. The Streets Department Traffic Division budget for fiscal year 2013 allocates \$45,000 out of the General Fund for the purchase of a roadway paint marking system. The Sherwin-Williams bid amount is \$3,672.78 (8%) over budget. Staff anticipates that the Traffic Division budget will not need to be amended solely on account of this bid price being over budget.

Options

In accordance with the bid documents, the City reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City accept the apparent lowest best bid, from Sherwin-Williams Paint Co. of Franklin, in the amount of \$48,672.78 for the specified trailered roadway paint marking system. Purchasing Manager Brian Wilcox is of the opinion that the prepared specifications as distributed allowed for competition among multiple vendors, and that the staff recommendation appears to be made in a fair and impartial manner based upon the bids received.
