SUBJECT: Consideration of contract award to Pinnacle Bank of Nashville, TN for banking services for the

fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, with three (3) options to extend for one (1) year each, not to

exceed a total of four (4) years as mutually agreed by both parties (Purchasing Office

Procurement Solicitation No. 2013-015; to be reflected in the proposed budget for fiscal year

2014; Contract No. 2013-0044)

### Purpose

The purpose of this procurement is to retain banking services for the City for the City fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, with three (3) options to extend for one (1) year each, not to exceed a total of four (4) years as mutually agreed by both parties.

### Background

The City published on February 28, 2013 a Notice to Bidders in the *Williamson Herald* for banking services. In addition, solicitation documents were sent on or about the same date directly to 23 potential proposers known or thought to be interested in this solicitation. Proposals from ten (10) financial institutions were publicly opened at the submittal opening held on April 9, 2013. A tabulation of the proposals received for this solicitation is attached.

#### **Financial Impact**

The proposal ranked highest by the proposal evaluation team, from Pinnacle Bank of Nashville, TN reflects a net return (interest earned by the City less actual or imputed charges paid by the City) in the approximate amount of \$7,500 per month based on average balances from the then most recent and available twelve-month period. The City allocates interest earned to each fund to which the interest is attributable, and allocates banking service fees to the Finance and Revenue Management departments.

#### **Options**

In accordance with the solicitation documents, the City reserves the right to reject any and all proposals.

#### Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City accept the proposal ranked highest by the proposal evaluation team, from Pinnacle Bank of Nashville, for banking services for the City for the City fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, with three (3) options to extend for one (1) year each, not to exceed a total of four (4) years as mutually agreed by both parties. Purchasing Manager Brian Wilcox is of the opinion that the prepared solicitation documents as distributed allowed for competition among multiple financial institutions, and that the staff recommendation appears to be made in a fair and impartial manner based upon the proposals received.
