All beer applications must have a training policy submitted with application. This policy must include training regarding the sale of beer to minors.

19. Please read the following and upon signature of this application, you do understand and agree to comply if you are granted a permit.
- (a) You will not sell beer or similar beverages except at the place or places for which the beer board has issued your permit.
  - (b) You will not sell beer or any like beverage except in accordance with the terms of said permit.
  - (c) If this application is made for permit to sell and not for consumption on the premises, you will not sell for consumption on the premises and not allow consumption on the premises.
  - (d) You will rigidly enforce the law against sales to minors.
  - (e) You will prohibit gambling at your establishment and understand that the conduct of such activities on the premises will result in revocation of your permit.
  - (f) You will secure a certificate or statement from the health department or health officer that the premises covered by the application meet the requirements of the ordinances of the City of Franklin and the laws of the State of Tennessee.
  - (g) You will not attempt to transfer this permit to anyone else.
  - (h) You will display this permit in a prominent place in your establishment.
  - (i) You will not sell or distribute beer between the hours of 3:00 AM and 6:00 AM (8:00 AM for on premises consumption) during the week and between the hours of 3:00 AM Sunday and 12:00 Noon Sunday (10:00 AM for on premises consumption).
  - (j) You will prohibit the congregation at your establishment of those who reasonably appear to be intoxicated, lawless, rowdy, or prostitutes.
  - (k) You will not allow any liquor with alcoholic content of greater than five percent (5%) to be consumed on the premises.

- (l) You will not allow any sale or delivery of beer for consumption on the premises outside of the building, it being the intention to prohibit the sale of beer by what is commonly known as "curb service" or "curb sales" of beer.
- (m) You will comply with all requirements of section 2-201 through 2-229 of the municipal code of the City of Franklin.

A non-refundable \$250 fee must accompany this application and the application shall be submitted at least fifteen (15) days prior to the Beer Board meeting at which it is to be considered. If the application is approved you are required to provide documentation of sales tax registration to the city within ten days of approval. Any applicant making false statement in this application shall forfeit his permit and shall not be eligible to receive any permit for a period of ten years.

A privilege tax of \$100 is imposed on the business of selling, distributing, storing or manufacturing beer in this state effective January 1, 1994 and each successive January 1. Any holder of a beer permit issued after January 1, 1994 shall pay a pro rata portion of this annual tax when the permit is issued.

*I hereby make application to the City of Franklin Beer Board for a beer permit.*

*The signing of this application acknowledges that I am aware of the laws prohibiting the sale of beer to minors.*

*I hereby certify that no person having at least a 5% ownership interest, nor any person to be employed in the distribution or sale of beer in my establishment has been convicted of any violation of the beer or alcoholic beverage laws or any crime involving moral turpitude within the past 10 years.*

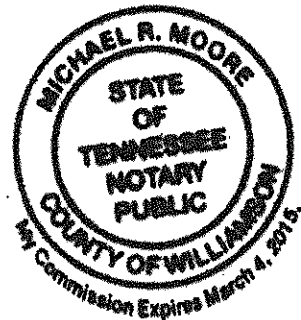

In regards to question #13 of the application packet, applicant Knights of Columbus Council #7764 hosted a social event at St. Philip Catholic Church in April 2013 at which beer was sold. Prior to hosting the event, the Knights of Columbus applied for and were approved for a 'Special Occasion' License by TABC (Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission). The event fell under TABC jurisdiction, as all beverages offered exceeded 5% ABV. (Alcohol by Volume)

## Alcohol Policy

1. All sales of alcoholic beverages will be restricted to persons 21 years and older. Those appearing to be underage will be asked to confirm their age with government-issued identification. If confirmation cannot be made, service will be refused.
2. Persons appearing to be intoxicated or exhibiting any type of disorderly behavior will be refused service.
3. All sales of alcohol will be for on-site consumption. Sales will take place in the Parish Community Center of St. Philip Catholic Church, 113 Second Ave, Franklin, TN.<sup>1</sup>
4. Alcohol sales will take place between the hours of 18:30-2300hrs.<sup>2</sup>
5. All serving/dispensing of alcoholic beverages will be managed by a combination of Knights of Columbus members and hired outside individuals. All persons will possess valid alcohol server permits issued by Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission.<sup>3</sup>
6. Applicant Knights of Columbus #7764 intends to comply with applicable State and Municipal Laws, as well as policies promulgated by The Roman Catholic Diocese of Nashville and St. Philip Parish.. The applicant respectfully requests an exemption from Municipal Code Title 8. Chapter 2 §8-226 subsection, 8. (Prohibition on alcoholic beverages in excess of 5% ABV.<sup>4</sup>)


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<sup>1</sup> The Knights of Columbus Council #7764 has obtained the written consent of Rev. Marneni Bala Showraiah, Pastor & Property Manager of St. Philip Parish to use the Parish facilities. A copy of which is included with the application documents.

<sup>2</sup> The start time of sales is approximate. Alcohol Sales may actually commence later, as they are contingent upon the conclusion of religious services preceding the event, and the approval of Rev. Marneni Bala Showraiah. A "last call" announcement will be made by the event's Master of Ceremonies prior to the conclusion of alcohol sales.

<sup>3</sup> Adrien Pepin, Knights of Columbus Council #7764 member, and managing agent of record, holds a valid permit. See attachment.

<sup>4</sup> As the Franklin Beer Board considers its application, applicant Knights of Columbus wishes to inform the Beer Board that it has simultaneously applied to the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission for a State Special Occasion License. It is the intent of the Knights to also include beverages in excess of 5%ABV at its event pending approval by the state. Should the state grant approval, beverages >5% ABV will be served in accordance with TABC Rule 0100-01-.07 & Tennessee Code §57-1-209, 57-4-102, and 57-4-201.

Sirs:

Reference is made to the information submitted by you for use in determining your status and the status of your local subordinate councils for Federal income and employment tax purposes.

It is the opinion of this office, based upon the evidence presented, that you and your subordinate councils listed in the "Directory of Councils and Officers, 1939-40" are exempt from Federal income tax under the provisions of section 101(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and the corresponding provisions of prior revenue acts.

Accordingly, you and your subordinate councils will not be required to file returns of income unless there is a change in the character of your organization, the purposes for which you were organized or your method of operation, or that of your subordinate councils. Any such changes should be immediately reported by you to this Bureau in order that the effect of such changes upon the present exempt status may be determined. You should furnish the Bureau annually, on the calendar year basis, lists in quadruplicate showing the names and addresses of any councils which were chartered during the calendar year and the names and addresses of any councils which for any reason ceased to exist. Such annual lists should be accompanied by a statement, sworn to by one of your principal officers, as to whether or not the information heretofore submitted by you and on which this ruling is based, is applicable in all respects to the new councils appearing on the lists, and should be forwarded so as to reach this office not later than February 15 of the following year.

The exemption evidenced by this letter relates specifically to Federal income tax, but since any organization which is exempt from such tax under the provisions of section 101 of the Internal

Revenue Code also is entitled to exemption from the capital stock tax pursuant to the express provisions of section 1201(a)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code, you and your subordinate councils will not be required to file capital stock tax returns for future years so long as the exemption from income tax is effective.

The determination of the status of your organization and subordinate councils for Federal employment tax purposes will be made the subject of a separate communication.

A copy of this ruling is being transmitted to the collectors of internal revenue for the several districts in which you and your subordinate councils are located.
