Purpose

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide information to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) for the consideration of a revision to Supplement #1 to the existing contract with TDOT (TDOT Contract No. 7913 / COF Contract No. 2012-0161) for the relocation of the water lines as required for the I65 Widening/Goose Creek Interchange Project.

Background

The original contract was approved by BOMA at the October 23, 2012 meeting. The original Supplement #1 was approved at the April 4, 2014 BOMA meeting. Since that approval TDOT has made some revisions to their typical Supplement document and would like for the City to sign a revised supplement.

Financial Impact

No Financial Impact. The revised contract supplement will not affect the reimbursement amount the City will be eligible for associated with water line relocation for the I-65 and Goose Creek Interchange Project.

Recommendation

Contingent upon document review by the City Engineer and City Attorney, staff recommends approval of the amendment referenced above.

SUPPLEMENT TO UTILITY RELOCATION CONTRACT

THIS SUPPLEMENT #1 to Contract No. 7913 made and entered into by and between the State of Tennessee acting through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter called "TDOT", and City of Franklin (Water), hereinafter called the "Utility".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, TDOT and the Utility entered into Contract No. 7913, dated the 10th day of December, 2012, in which the parties agreed to certain matters concerning the relocation of utilities on PIN No. 106269.01, From North of SR-840 to North of SR-248 (Includes SR-248 – Goose Creek Interchange located in Williamson County, Tennessee.; and

WHEREAS, it is desired by the parties that the hereinafter mentioned changes be made in said original contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, for a valuable consideration it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

To change paragraph,

WHEREAS, the Utility has furnished TDOT with an estimate, plans, and specifications showing the cost and manner of relocating these facilities, which estimate is in the amount of \$657,412.77, including the amount of \$38,842.77 for the cost of engineering; including the amount of \$0.00 for the cost of inspection provided by the Utility; including the amount of \$62,000.00 for the cost of betterment to the Utility's facilities (hereinafter called the "Betterment Cost"), and including the amount of \$0.00 for the cost over the maximum TDOT reimbursement amount, and of which 42 percent represents the pro-rata share to which the Utility is entitled to reimbursement for relocation of utility facilities located on private utility right-of-way, and 58 percent represents the pro-rata share for relocation of utility facilities located on public highway right-of-way, reimbursement being for the cost of construction, engineering and inspection, excluding betterment and the cost over the maximum TDOT reimbursement amount; and It is understood that the above are the only changes made in said contract.

To the following,

WHEREAS, the Utility has furnished TDOT with an estimate, plans, and specifications showing the cost and manner of relocating these facilities, which estimate is in the amount of \$909,159.61, including the amount of \$55,581.61 for the cost of engineering; including the amount of \$123,520.00 for the cost of inspection provided by the Utility; including the amount of Betterment Cost"), and including the amount of \$0.00 for the cost over the maximum TDOT reimbursement amount, and of which 42 percent represents the pro-rata share to which the Utility is entitled to reimbursement for relocation of utility facilities located on private utility right-of-way, and 58 percent represents the pro-rata share for relocation of utility facilities located on public highway right-of-way, reimbursement being for the cost of construction, engineering and inspection, excluding betterment and the cost over the maximum TDOT

reimbursement amount; and It is understood that the above are the only changes made in said contract.
