Material that is washed or dumped into the Storm drain system that is not entirely Stormwater




Things You Can Do At Home

- Wash Your Vehicle Over a Grassy Area to Prevent Detergents from Running off into Storm Drains.

 Materials such as Paints, Antifreeze,
