Governor Haslam announced his proposal to address sustainable funding for state transportation needs. Our legislative delegation has asked local governments to weigh in on the proposal. After a full review, we will likely bring a resolution to the **Franklin Board of Mayor and Aldermen** for consideration of support.

The **City of Franklin** and the Downtown Franklin Association and Heritage Foundation is working with **Mars Petcare**, "**Better Cities for Pets**" program. Mars is asking the City of Franklin to be a Pilot Program to promote pet friendliness in the city. A committee of community volunteers is working with Mars to find ways to make pet owners aware that the downtown shops are welcoming to pets and visitors with pets. Look for a launch of the program sometime this Spring and more information coming soon.

Our **Special Census** is ongoing and City Census workers are out in neighborhoods collecting the data manually for those who have not filled out the form online or by mail. It is easy to do and literally only takes a few minutes at <a href="https://www.franklintn.gov/2017specialcensus">www.franklintn.gov/2017specialcensus</a>. As of this week we have counted just over 50,000 people, but we believe we have at least 70,000 citizens currently. All we ask is for your address and the names of the people who live in your home! Census workers also plan to be at area Kroger stores every Saturday through the end of the month.

A second **Columbia Avenue widening** public involvement meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, January 31 from 6-8pm at the City Hall Training Room located at 109 3rd Avenue South, Franklin, TN, 37064. A formal presentation will begin at 6:30 p.m., with individual discussions at 6:00 p.m. and again after the presentation. Attendees will learn about the proposed design concepts from City staff and the project team and have the opportunity to provide feedback.
