Earlier today, the **Tennessee Local Development Authority (TLDA) approved three loans totaling \$100 million for the City's upgrade and expansion of the Water**



Reclamation **Facility**. The loan is for a 30-year period at an interest rate of 1.47%. This is a great deal for Franklin and will **save** our rate payers at least \$30 million over the life of the

loan compared to typical bond financing. A big thank you to our team for their work on securing this loan!
