Consideration of bid award to Maury Fence Co. of Columbia, TN in the amount of \$120,000.00 (\$90,000.00 in FY2010; \$30,000.00 in FY2011 if budgeted) for supply, delivery and installation

of fencing At Fieldstone Park ball fields for the Parks Department (Purchasing Office

Procurement Solicitation No. 2010-035; \$90,000.00 Budgeted In 110-89530-44700 for fiscal year

2010)

Purpose

The purpose of this procurement is to purchase the supply, delivery and installation of new fencing for the ballfields at Fieldstone Park. This new fencing would replace existing fencing at this same location that is 23 years old and in poor condition.

Background

The Parks Department budget for fiscal year 2010 allocates \$90,000 out of the General Fund for the purchase of replacement athletic field fencing at Fieldstone Park.

Financial Impact

The City published on March 25, 2010 a Notice to Bidders in the *Williamson Herald* for the supply, delivery and installation of fencing at Fieldstone Park ballfields. In addition, bid documents were sent on or about the same date directly to eight (8) potential bidders known or thought to be interested in this solicitation. Bids from three (3) vendors were publicly opened at the bid opening held on April 15, 2010. A tabulation of the bids received for this solicitation is attached. The apparent lowest, most responsive and responsible bid, from Maury Fence Co. of Columbia, TN, is in the amount of \$30,000.00 per field or \$120,000.00 for the specified four (4) fields. This bid was identified because it is the lowest bid that meets or exceeds the City's intention as expressed and implied by the City's specifications as well as the instructions, terms and conditions pertaining to this procurement solicitation. The budget for FY2010 anticipated this project costing \$45,000.00 per field so, on a per-field basis, the apparent lowest best bid amount is \$15,000.00 (33%) under budget.

Options

The specifications included the following provision:

Bid evaluation, award and authorization to proceed: The City will use the quoted pricing for fencing for all four ballfields to evaluate the bids. The City intends for all of the fencing work to be done at Fieldstone Park ball complex to be awarded to one (1) single vendor. However, the City cannot guarantee that fencing work for fields nos. 3 & 4 will be authorized. Therefore, bidders should prepare pricing based on the assumption that two (2) separate authorizations to proceed will be issued – the first for fields nos. 1 & 2 to be issued possibly as soon as May 12, 2010 but no later than May 28, 2010, and the second for fields nos. 3 & 4 to be issued possibly as soon as July 1, 2010 but no later than July 31, 2010.





Because the bid prices came in so much below budget, staff recommends BOMA award the project with three fields to be funded in the current fiscal year and the one remaining field to be funded in fiscal year 2011 if budgeted. Maury Fence Co. has agreed to this schedule if it is awarded the project.

In accordance with the bid documents, the City reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City accept the apparent lowest best bid, from Maury Fence Co. of Columbia, TN, in the amount of \$120,000.00 for supply, delivery and installation of fencing at Fieldstone Park ball fields for the Parks Department. Staff further recommends that the award be split over two fiscal years, with three fields to be funded in the current fiscal year for a total of \$90,000.00 and the one remaining field to be funded in fiscal year 2011 if budgeted for \$30,000.00. Purchasing Manager Brian Wilcox is of the opinion that the prepared specifications as distributed allowed for competition among multiple vendors, and that the staff recommendation appears to be made in a fair and impartial manner based upon the bids received.
