

**RESOLUTION 2010-31**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FREE BUILDING PERMITS FOR STRUCTURES  
DAMAGED BY THE MAY 2010 FLOOD**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Franklin experienced flooding conditions during May 1 and 2, 2010, which caused damage to many residential and commercial structures; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Franklin, by executive order dated May 2, 2010, was declared a state of emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin Municipal Code requires permits for work done to residential and commercial structures; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen, upon recommendation by the City Staff, believes it to be in the City's best interest to offer the required building permits free to those whose residential and/or commercial structures were damaged by the flood.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE THAT:**

All building permits for residential and commercial structures issued to remedy damage as a result of the May 2010 flood shall be free of charge.
