

**RESOLUTION 2010-32**

**A RESOLUTION TERMINATING THE WATER SHORTAGE EMERGENCY STATUS 2 RELATED TO  
THE MAY 2010 FLOOD**

**WHEREAS**, John C. Schroer, Mayor of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, pursuant to authority in Franklin Municipal Code Section 18-130(3), declared that a Water Shortage Emergency Status 1 existed on May 3, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin Municipal Code Section 18-130(5)(d) provides that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen may terminate or modify any limitations on non-essential use of water under such a shortage, and

**WHEREAS**, the attached document issued by the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation conveys that water shortage conditions have since ceased.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE THAT:**

The prohibitions set forth in the **DECLARATION OF WATER SHORTAGE EMERGENCY STATUS 2** on May 3, 2010 shall be lifted and are no longer in effect.
