RESOLUTION 2010-33

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO USE DISCRETION REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FRANKLIN MUNICIPAL CODE AS IT PERTAINS TO CITY UTILITY CUSTOMERS IMPACTED BY THE MAY 2010 FLOOD

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin experienced flooding conditions during May 1 and 2, 2010, which caused damage to many residential and commercial structures; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, by executive order dated May 2, 2010, was declared a state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin Municipal Code provides for the process and method of disconnecting water from customers who are delinquent in payment, for connecting water to a new residence, and for water leaks; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen understand that utility customers may find it difficult to make timely utility payments and understand that there may be circumstances that require discretion by the City Administrator.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE THAT:

Upon receipt of proof from utility customers that he/she was directly affected by the May 1-2, 2010 flood, the City Administrator is granted discretion to decide if and when the utility service shall be disconnected and what, if any, fees shall be assessed for late payments, leak adjustments or connection to water from a different location.
