Diana Beasley and Kevin Lindsey visited the BGA **Lower school** (Kindergarten class) for a mock park dedication project that the kids had to complete this year. The project is handed out to the children by the teachers and then the teachers have very limited input about the design of the park going forward. The children are asked to create a committee in which all the park amenities/ideas are discussed. The construction phase of the park consists of

colored paper cut-outs for all amenities on a bulletin board size wall that creates the foot print of the park. Each child will then stand at the park and share what they have built and show its location in the park. This year they named the park "The Ultimate Park" and it was around 8 to 9 acres in size. They included the Harpeth River that runs through the center of the park and even had a café to purchase coffee while visiting. After they



presented to the city we shared the **South East Park concept** plan to show the relation.
