To date total of 9,539 households have signed up for the Blue Bin service, up about 400 from last Friday! The Certified Public Infrastructure Inspector certification program is intended for individuals who inspect the construction of public infrastructure (e.g., roadways, highways, utilities, bridges, dams) and facilities (e.g., pump stations, treatment plants, water storage facilities) and other types of construction work and materials to ensure compliance with plans and specifications. Duties may include observation, measurement, testing, and documentation. Casey is one a very few individuals that have passed this test in the State of Tennessee. This is quite an accomplishment, and the Street Department is very proud of him!
