



## **Key Changes:**

**Up 2,389** more positive cases day over day in the State of Tennessee (71,450 total positive cases – **most total positive cases since the pandemic began**).

**Up 1053** more active cases day over day in the State of Tennessee (29,494 total active cases – **most since the pandemic began**).

**Up 98** more positive cases day over day in Williamson County (2,217 total positive cases – third highest single daily increase, most total positive cases since the pandemic began).


**Up 39** more active cases day over day in Williamson County (1,334 total active cases – **most total active cases since the pandemic began**).


**Up** Williamson County share of total positive cases within Tennessee at 3.1%

**Up** Percent Positive / Total Tested at 7.3%

**Level** Williamson County sixth highest # of positive cases in Tennessee

**Level** No additional deaths in Williamson County (18 – <u>tied for seventh</u> highest in state)
