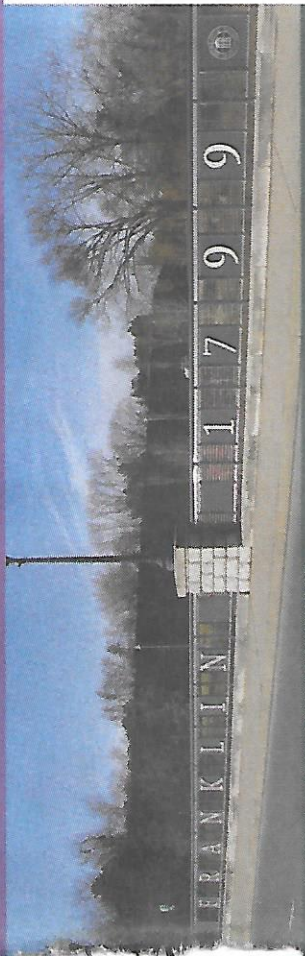




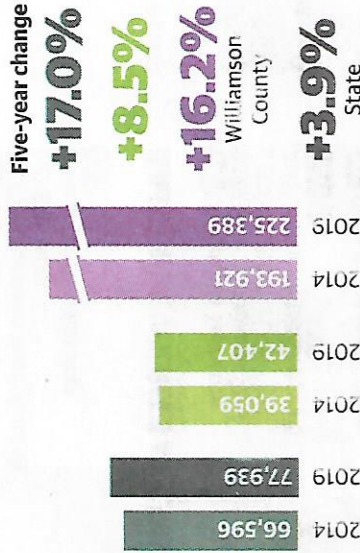

FRANKLIN

Founded in 1799, the city of Franklin is home to the seat of Williamson County as well as to several battlefield sites and historic homes from the Civil War era. The city is governed by the board of mayor and aldermen and holds elections every two years.
