**Up 357 More** positive cases day over day in Williamson County (19,703 total positive cases) \*new single day record\*


**Up** 78 More active cases day over day in Williamson County (2,396 total active cases

**Level** Williamson County **Seventh** highest # of positive cases in Tennessee


