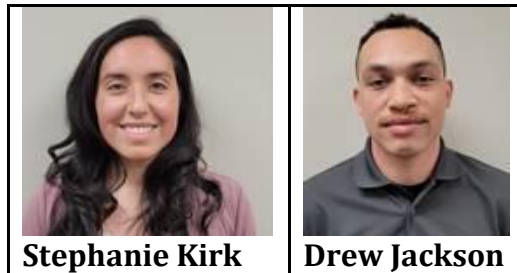

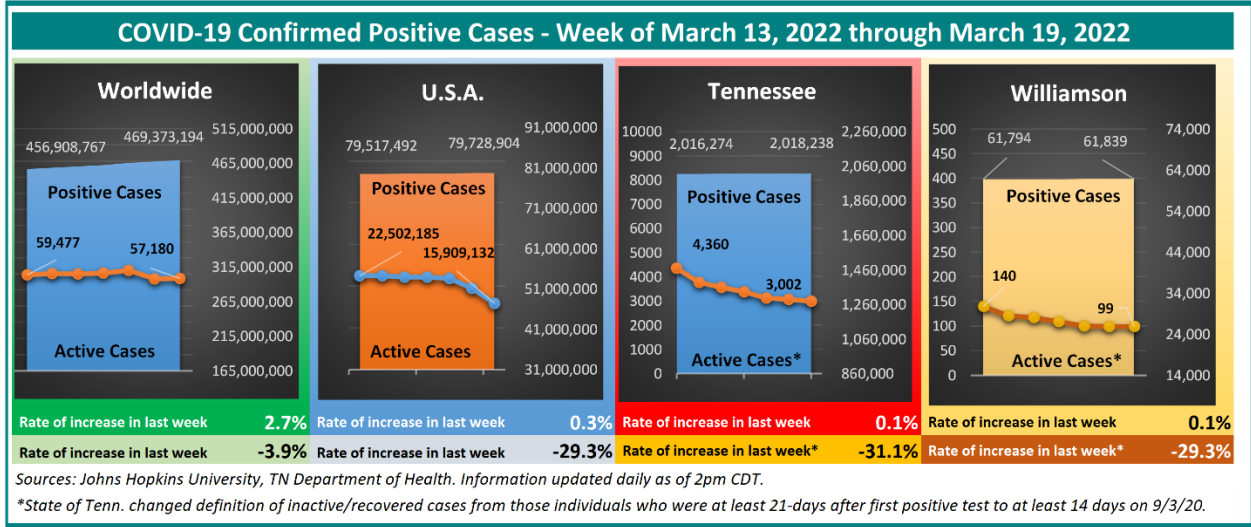
*We are grateful to see continued decline with the active case now under 100 for the County.*

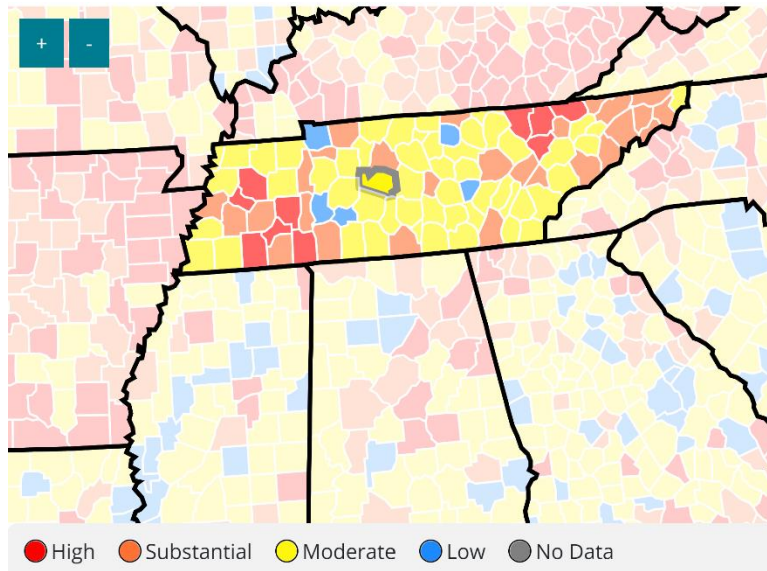
**Up 174 More** positive cases day over day in the State of Tennessee (2,018,238 total positive cases)
