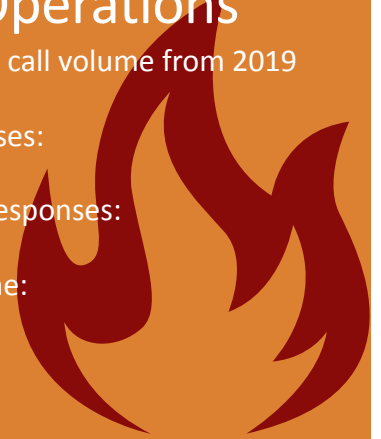

- Due to COVID-19, public events and education shifted to a virtual format. Highlights of the year included Virtual Fire Prevention Month and parades. We participated in **63** reverse or “drive-by” parades to help citizens celebrate birthdays, graduations, retirements, the completion of chemo treatments, Veterans Day, and more. This included escorting Santa Claus and his sleigh through more than **50** Franklin neighborhoods on the four Saturdays between Thanksgiving and Christmas. The initial Facebook post announcing Santa’s schedule reached more than **49,000** people. We worked with the GIS team to create a Santa Tracker, which allowed residents to see where Santa was on his route. From November 27 through December 18, 2020 (the final Santa parade), the Santa Tracker was accessed **28,370** times.
