Mechanical - Electrical Permit

Effective August 15, 2022

**A separate electrical inspection is required for all HVAC work performed on
Residential structures**

Permit requirement

- An Electrical license is not required for this inspection
- An Electrical inspection will be added to an approved Mechanical permit.

Inspection process

- The mechanical contractor will be responsible for scheduling an individual electrical inspection for equipment connections on residential structures when work is completed.
- Per the 2017 National Electrical Code (NFPA 72), Inspections will be performed for code compliant connections from the point of Electrical contractor D-mark to the HVAC equipment installed.
- When code deficiencies are identified, a correction notice will be placed in the outside equipment disconnect.
- When a correction notice is left on site, it is the responsibility of the Mechanical contractor to correct the work and request a re-inspection of the work performed.
