ORDINANCE NO. 630

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 13-106 (1) and (2) AND SECTION 13-112 OF THE FRANKLIN MUNICIPAL CODE"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Section 13-106 (1) and (2) of "The Franklin Municipal Code" be amended by deleting the present language in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

"13-106. Connection charges.

"(1) For a 3/4" service line located inside the corporate limits of the Town of Franklin, Tennessee, the cost of which is not estimated to exceed the amount of the applicable amount deposited thereunder, the sum of \$150.00.

"(2) For a 3/4" service line located outside the corporate limits of the Town of Franklin, Tennessee, the cost of which is not estimated to exceed the amount of the applicable amount deposited hereunder, the sum of \$175.00."

SECTION 2: That Section 13-112 of "The Franklin Municipal Code" be amended by adding the following language as a new paragraph:

"The following rates shall be, and are hereby, established for water distributed within the Corporate Limits of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, by the City of Franklin:

Next 7,000 gallons	0.84	per	1000 gallons
Next 15,000 gallons			1000 gallons

"For all water furnished by the City of Franklin to consumers outside the corporate limits of the City of Franklin, the rate charged shall be one hundred seventy (170%) percent of the rate charged to consumers who are furnished water within the corporate limits of the City of Franklin, Tennessee."

SECTION 3: Section 1 of this Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by third and final reading, the public welfare demanding it and Section 2 of this Ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 1974 the public welfare demanding it.

ORDINANCE NO. 631

AN ORDINANCE TO FIX THE SALARY OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE AND OTHER MEMBERS OF POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee:

Section 1: That the compensation for the employees of the Franklin Police Department shall be as follows, according to rank and position:

Police Sergeant, Step 3	3.58
Police Lieutenant, Step 3	3.75
Assistant Chief of Police, Step 3	4.14
Meter Maid, Step 2	2.42

SECTION 2: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the cost of living increase shall be added to the above mentioned pay for members of the Police Department and to the present pay for the members of the Fire Department.

ORDINANCE 85-36

TO BE ENTITLED:

"AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 13-112 OF THE FRANKLIN MUNICIPAL CODE TO ESTABLISH RATES FOR WATER DISTRIBUTED WITHIN AND WITHOUT THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE."

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that Section 13-112 of the Franklin Municipal Code shall be, and is hereby, amended so as to read in its entirety as follows:

13-112. Schedule of rates. The following rates shall be, and are hereby, established for water distributed within the corporate limits of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, by the City of Franklin:

Next 3500 Gallons	\$1.65 per 1000

For all water furnished by the City of Franklin to consumers outside the corporate limits of the City of Franklin, the rate charged shall be one hundred seventy percent (170%) of the rate charged to consumers who are furnished water within the corporate limits of the City of Franklin, Tennessee. A sewer service charge of ninety percent (90%) of the water rate shall be added to and combined with the water charge. To the sewer service charge shall be added the state sewer fee, which is five percent (5%) of the sewer service charge.

Provided, however, each customer shall be charged a minimum monthly bill based on the size of the meter monitoring water service to the customer's premises, which bill shall entitle the customer to receive a certain minimum number of gallons of water per month, as follows:

In the event a customer does not use the water to which it is entitled by virtue of paying the minimum bill, the customer's right to receive such unused water during a billing period shall be forfeited. Unused entitlements may not carry forward from month-to-month. (as replaced by Ord. No. 85-36)

SECTION II. BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens demanding it.






Present the percent recovery for water and wastewater based on only the approved BOMA projects.

Water Percent Recovery WITHOUT ADDITIONAL Debt Service




Water Percent Recovery with Debt Service for APPROVED and PENDING Projects











Wastewater Percent Recovery WITHOUT ADDITIONAL Debt Service






Wastewater Percent Recovery with Debt Service for APPROVED and PENDING Projects

Purpose

The purpose of this memorandum is to present to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) for their consideration, proposed Ordinance 2012-57, amending the water and sanitary sewer rates for the City of Franklin.

Background

The City of Franklin has completed an independent third-party cost of service study to evaluate the City's progress related to the Water Management Department's five year financial plan approved in 2010. The City has made significant strides toward achieving a rate structure to meet the full cost of service for both water and sanitary sewer and is either on track or ahead of schedule relative to the five year plan.

Starting in late 2009, the City embarked on an integrated water resources planning process to help provide a roadmap for the City's water resources related activities, projects, and policies. A result of this process was the identification of several priority projects in both water and sanitary sewer.

The proposed rate adjustments are consistent with rate adjustments proposed in the fourth and fifth years of the five year financial plan and support the implementation of the BOMA approved integrated water resources plan projects. While staff is proposing two years of rate adjustments with this ordinance, the second year will be reviewed and presented to the BOMA prior to the effective date to ensure the adjustment remains appropriate and consistent with the needs of the utility system.

Staff has presented the cost of service study to the Finance Committee on September 26, 2012 (an overview only) and during the BOMA Work Session on October 9, 2012. Information requested during that meeting has been provided in a separate memorandum dated October 12, 2012.

Options

The Board may choose to adopt, amend, and deny the proposed rate increases. Based on the Board's adopted five year financial plan including a five year rate structure, three options have been presented:

1. Allocate the planned rate increase to the availability charge, which includes the fixed system costs plus the first 1,000 gallons.





- 2. Allocate the planned rate increase to the variable, consumption rate.
- 3. Allocate the planned rate increase equally to the availability charge and the consumption charge. This has been referred to as the "hybrid" model.

Financial Impact

The proposed rate adjustments for water and sanitary sewer are projected to increase annual revenues by approximately 4% and 7% respectively for the adjustments proposed for January 1, 2013 and for the adjustments proposed for January 1, 2014. The recommended rate increases would be split equally between the fixed, availability charge and the usage-based rate ("hybrid" option).

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the BOMA approve Ordinance 2012-57 to amending the water and sanitary sewer rates, using option #3, the "hybrid" approach.

WATER

- Option A: Increase the monthly customer charge by \$1.50 each year for two years for each rate class.
- Option B: Increase monthly customer charge by \$0.75 each year for each rate class and increase volumetric charge by \$0.11 each year for each rate class.
- Option C: Increase volumetric charge by \$0.22 each year for each rate class.

SEWER

- Option A: Increase monthly customer charge by \$2.32 each year for two years for each rate class.
- Option B: Increase monthly customer charge by \$1.16 each year for each rate class and increase volumetric charge by \$0.14 each year for each rate class.
- Option C: Increase volumetric charge by \$0.28 each year for each rate class.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF FRANKLIN MUNICIPAL CODE, APPENDIX A - COMPREHENSIVE FEES AND PENALTIES, CHAPTER 18 – WATER & SEWERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF UPDATING WATER, SANITARY SEWER, AND RECLAIMED WATER USER RATES

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Tennessee, has completed an independent third-party cost of service study that recommended increases in water, sanitary sewer, and reclaimed water service rates and fees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor & Aldermen determined that rate planning should be conducted on a regular basis to ensure rate sufficiency; and

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee requires that rates and fees be charged adequately in order to cover costs of such service; and

WHEREAS, two options are presented in front of the Board for water and sewer user rates and a recommendation for reclaimed water user rates, outlined as follows:

WATER

- Option A: Increase the Monthly Customer Charge for each Rate Class in year one by \$2.21 and in year two by \$1.72.
- Option B: Increase the monthly Customer Charge for each rate class in year one by \$1.10 and in year two by \$0.86. Increase the Volumetric Charge for each rate class in year one by \$0.18 and in year two by \$0.14.

SEWER

- Option A: Increase the monthly Customer Charge for Residential in, Residential Out and Commercial – in, in year one by \$2.05 and in year two by \$1.76.
- Option B: Increase the monthly Customer Charge for Residential in, Residential Out and Commercial In, in year one by \$1.02 and in year two by \$0.88. Increase the Volumetric Charge for Residential in, Residential Out and Commercial In, in year one by \$0.14 and in year two by \$0.12.

RECLAIMED WATER

Increase the Volumetric Charge in year one and year two by \$0.10 each year.
