It's that time of year again! Open enrollment is starting Monday! Please see below for important information.

Dates: Monday, May 22 - Friday, June 16

Any enrollment changes <u>MUST</u> be made during this timeframe. Late enrollments cannot be accepted. You can make changes to your medical (BCBS), dental (Delta), vision (Eye Med) and voluntary products (Ochs/Securian) without a life event during this period. Please login to UKG self-service to make any changes. All changes will be effective 7/1/2023 and reflected with pay date 7/14/2023.

Things to Note

- ✓ Premiums are NOT changing. All premiums will remain the same.
- ✓ Our new voluntary product carrier for Short-Term Disability and Voluntary Group Term Life Insurance, OCHS is offering a one-time only true open enrollment for voluntary group term life policies. Meaning, for those that declined coverage in the past or want to increase coverage, you may elect up to the guaranteed issue amount with no health questions!

Employee guaranteed issue amount - \$250,000

Spouse guaranteed issue amount - \$30,000

Child(ren) guaranteed issue amount - \$15,000

✓ HSA Employer Contributions 2023 Rates - ***Employer contributions will be divided among two equal payments deposited into employee HSA accounts on July 1, 2023 and January 12, 2024.***

No changes? No problem!

If you do not want to change your current benefit enrollments, you will NOT need to make any new selections in UKG. Nothing will be required of you to keep your current elections.

REMINDER: Here are a few bullet points to share in regard to **using technology and communications via email for everyone to be mindful of.** Tips to remember:

- Use complex passwords, something not easy. (example of what not to use: Password123, Login1, Birthday, etc.)
- Please do not save passwords in an unprotected document or share with colleagues, these are your passwords and

yours only. IT can always reset or change in the event there is a business need for operations.

- Use caution when opening emails from unknown senders when they sound weird, or not exactly on point.
- Use extreme caution when opening an email link that is asking for credentials that looks fishy.
- Never under any circumstance share your passwords via email.

• If you have the option to use MFA, multi-factor authentication, professionally and in your personal life please do. IT is currently working to get this security layer deployed across the enterprise for all users.
