Outside Agency Funding Types

- Internal Revenue Code Section 501c3: a nonprofit organization that has been approved by the IRS as a tax-exempt, charitable organization (organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, testing for public safety, literary, educational, or other specified purpose). Appropriation requirements per T.C.A. 6-54-111, as amended.
- Internal Revenue Code Section 501c4 and 501c6: a nonprofit civic organization that has been approved by the IRS as a tax-exempt organization which "...direct[s] their efforts at promoting the common economic interests of all commercial enterprises in a trade or community". Appropriation requirements per T.C.A. 6-54-111, as amended.
- Government: Williamson County and its agencies and the State of Tennessee or any of its political subdivisions or instrumentalities that serve the City of Franklin.



Base Budget Request

The Appropriations budget provides for the allotment of City of Franklin funds to various outside agencies, functions and programs that are under IRS classifications 501c3, 501c4, 501c6, and government

Program Enhancement Requests

In addition to the existing requests for funding under the Appropriations budget, there are twelve increase requests (totaling \$58,716) to address increased need in the community.
