The City of Franklin (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Hamlet Drive Low Pressure Sewer

Sealed and endorsed Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **City of Franklin Purchasing Office** located at 109 3rd Avenue South, Suite 107, Franklin, TN 37064, until **June 27, 2024** at **2:00 pm** local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. No bid shall be accepted after the stated date and time.

The Project includes the following Work:

Approximately 650 linear feet of 2-Inch PVC low pressure sewer, six (6) 1% - inch low pressure services with valves and cleanout boxes, one (1) manhole on existing 10-inch gravity sewer line and asphalt trench repair

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. The Project has an expected duration of 180 days to substantial completion after the date when the Contract Times commence to run and 210 days to readiness for final payment after the date when the Contract Times commence to run. Bids shall be on a unit price basis as indicated in the Bid Form.

Bidding Documents may be downloaded from the designated website. Prospective Bidders are urged to register with the designated website as a plan holder, even if Bidding Documents are obtained from a plan room or source other than the designated website in either electronic or paper format. The designated website will be updated periodically with addenda, reports, and other information relevant to submitting a Bid for the Project. All official notifications, addenda, and other Bidding Documents will be offered only through the designated website. Owner will not be responsible for Bidding Documents, including addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the designated website.

Instructions to Bidders

Bidders will be required to submit a Bid Security in the amount of five percent (5%) of Bidder's maximum. Bid price in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Upon Contract award, the Successful Bidder must provide performance and payment bonds in accordance with the General Conditions, as may be modified by the Supplementary Conditions, at the time of delivery of the executed Agreement to the Owner.

Bidders must be licensed contractors as required by Tennessee Code Annotated (TCA) §62-6-103 and §62-6-112. Bidders are required to provide evidence of compliance with TCA Title 62, Chapter 6 before any Bidder's Bid may be considered.

If Bidder prefers to submit its Bid on paper rather than by means of the Owner's online sourcing application, then, pursuant to TCA §62-6-119, each Contractor/ Bidder applying to bid for the prime contract and for any masonry contract where the total masonry portion of the construction project exceeds one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00), materials and labor, electrical, plumbing, heating, ventilation, and air conditioning contracts, is required to place his / her paper Bid in a sealed envelope showing the Bidder's name, contractor license number, license expiration date, and license classification, and for electrical, plumbing, heating, ventilation and air conditioning contracts and for each vertical closed loop geothermal heating and cooling project, the company name, Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) license number, classification, and the expiration date of same, on the outside of the envelope using the State Contractor Licensing Information Form (Section C-00300), except when the Bid is in an amount less than twenty -five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00). Bids submitted by means of the Owner's online sourcing application rather than on paper shall complete and include the State Contractor Licensing Information Form (Section 00300) as an attachment to the Bid. Only one (1) contractor in such classification may be listed. Prime contractor Bidders who are to perform the masonry portion of the construction project which exceeds one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00), materials and labor, the electrical, plumbing, heating, ventilation and air conditioning must be so designated upon the State Contractor Licensing Information Form (Section 00300). Bids not conforming to these legal requirements are void and shall not be considered. Bids less than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) may contain only the name of the contractor on the State Contractor Licensing Information Form (Section 00300). Upon opening the Bid, if such Bid is in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00), the same shall be automatically disqualified and shall not be considered.

Per Tennessee Department of Commerce & Insurance Board for Licensing Contractors Rule 0 680-01-.24 (2), award of a subcontract to one not listed on the State Contractor Licensing Information Form (Section 00300) in violation of TCA §62-6-119 will be subject to review and disciplinary action by the Board.

If the Bidder prefers to submit its Bid on paper rather than by means of the Owner's online sourcing application, then one set of unbound Bidding Documents with original signatures shall be submitted. Regardless of whether Bidder submit its Bid on paper or by means of the Owner's online sourcing application, each Bidder must include with the Bid completed and signed statement of Bidder's Qualifications, Contractor Safety Information, and acknowledgement of Receipt of Contractor Safety Program.
