ORDINANCE 2024-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE TO AMEND APPENDIX A – COMPREHENSIVE FEES AND PENALTIES, CHAPTER 17 REFUSE AND TRASH DISPOSAL, OF THE FRANKLIN MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCREASE THE FEES FOR COLLECTION OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE.

WHEREAS, for the purpose of promoting the public health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the people of Franklin, Tennessee, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen is authorized to prescribe regulations and standards that encourage and advance the quality of life within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin Board of Mayor and Aldermen have, on behalf of the citizens of Franklin, invested in a solid waste management facility located at 411 Century Court; and

WHEREAS, the City has performed a cost of service study identifying the need to adjust rates in order to have self-sustaining funding for the Sanitation and Environmental Services Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter, Article VIII, provides for adoption of an annual budget for all departments of the City of Franklin; and

WHEREAS, an annual budget process appropriating funds to the various departments and divisions of the City government for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, has been completed in accordance with state law and local ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:
