ORDINANCE 2024-25

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ALL-WAY STOP CONTROL AT THE INTERSECTION OF JEWELL AVENUE AND RIPLEY LANE

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Tennessee, received a request from Williamson County Schools and the Westhaven Homeowner's Association to establish all-way stop control at the intersection of Jewell Avenue and Ripley Lane; and

WHEREAS, the intersection of Jewell Avenue and Ripley Lane is currently configured with stop control only on the Ripley Lane approach; and

WHEREAS, Engineering Department Staff has completed a multiway stop engineering study examining the Pearre Creek Elementary School vehicle and pedestrian activity, including student street crossings; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department recommends the establishment of all-way stop control at the intersection of Jewell Avenue and Ripley Lane for the following reasons: high pedestrian activity, multiple school student crossings across non-stop controlled Jewell Avenue, and witnessing non-compliance of vehicles yielding to pedestrians at an established and marked pedestrian crossing at the intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That all-way stop control shall be established at the intersection of Jewell Avenue and Ripley Lane.

SECTION II. That the Director of the Streets Department is hereby authorized and directed to install stop signs at said location to regulate traffic approaching this intersection.

SECTION III. That the penalty for failure to obey the provisions of this Ordinance shall be as indicated in the Franklin Municipal Code and/or the Tennessee Code Annotated.

SECTION IV. BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage on second and final reading, the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Franklin requiring it.
