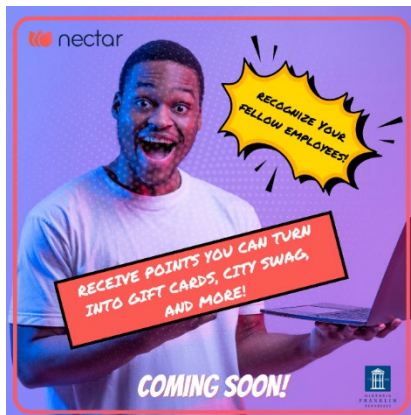

This week, **30 Franklin Firefighters** completed a **40-hour wildland firefighter course**, taught in-house by lead instructor **Firefighter James Hinkle** with supporting instructors **Lt.-P Dustin Anderson, FF-P Brad Kamau, FF Bobby Martens, FF-P Robbie Radican, and FF Evan Williams**. This Tennessee-commission approved course concluded with the wildland firefighter pack test, where participants wore a 45-pound weighted vest and walked three miles within 45 minutes. They are now on track to receive their Wildland Firefighter I and II certifications, pending the state test and completion of the certification application process.

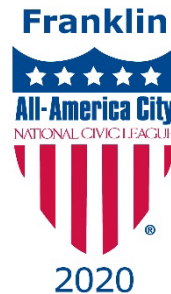
John Holland, Building Inspector II, Building and Neighborhood Services
