Hello,

As was discussed during the neighborhood meeting, Garney was given their Notice to Proceed this past Monday, July 8th. This date contractually starts their timeline of how long the work should take, and if it extends beyond what we have specified, the City can potentially recoup some of the costs associated with that delay. During this past week, they have been mobilizing in preparation for beginning work this next Monday, July 15th. As you can see from the attached traffic control plan for this first phase of work (picture below and PDF is attached), there will be impacts to the 5-Points intersection as we set a new manhole on the south side of the intersection and replace the water and sewer lines in this area. The orange area is the area that will be blocked off from access, there will be no traffic in the following areas:

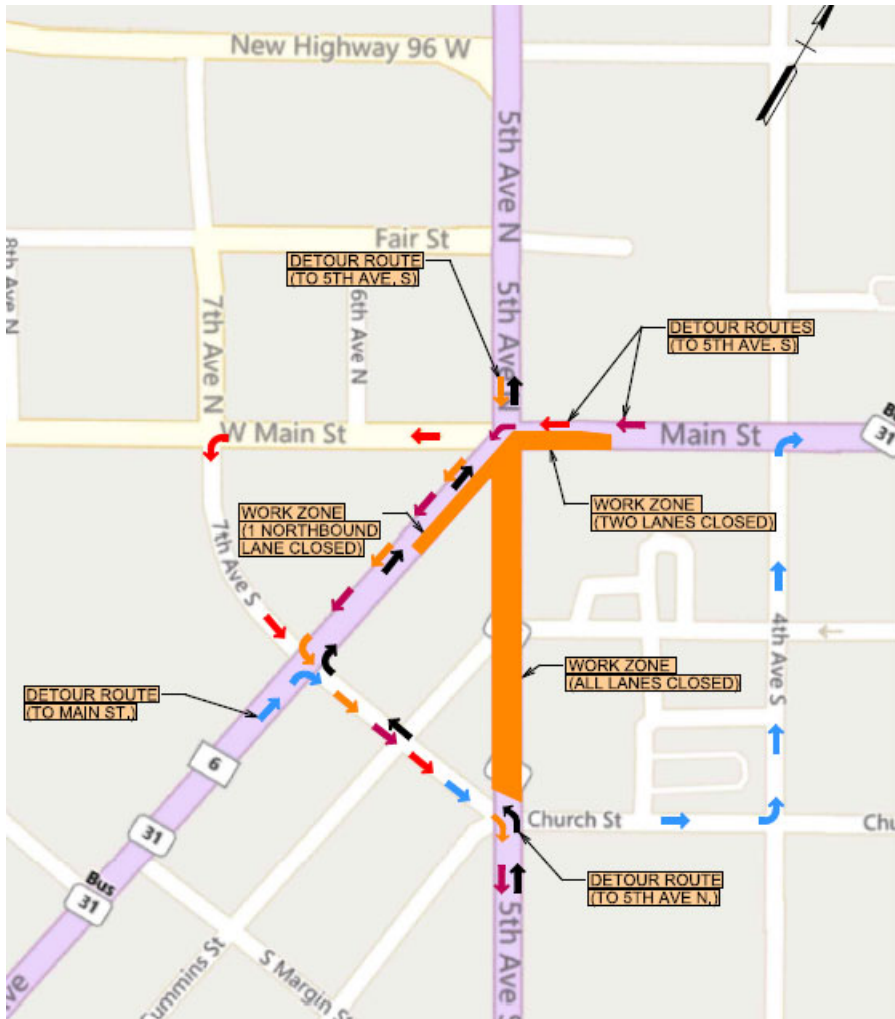
- East bound from Columbia to Main
- North bound on 5th from Church to Main

All other traffic lanes will remain open for use.

Please note, that while you will see the Contractor's presence in this area beginning Monday, there are significant preparations that will need to be made for complete traffic closures. It may take a day or two to see the lanes actually blocked off and all of the signs up, but they are working to get everything established as quickly as possible.

Also, the Contractor is using the Water Treatment Plant at 838 Lewisburg as a staging area for equipment and materials - this means there will be large machinery entering/exiting the road in this area. Please use caution in this area.
