**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN AUTO ALLOWANCE FOR THE MAYOR
OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN**

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Franklin currently receives reimbursement for actual mileage driven in his personal vehicle to represent the City at numerous meetings and functions across the city, Nashville area and the State of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor is asked to represent the City at additional meetings and functions as the City grows in population; and

WHEREAS, it would be more efficient for the City to provide the Mayor with an auto allowance in lieu of paying mileage reimbursement at the standard per mile rate set by the IRS; and

WHEREAS, it is proposed to provide the Mayor with the same amount of auto allowance funds as provided to the City Administrator.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Franklin as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor of the City of Franklin shall receive an auto allowance of the same amount provided to the City Administrator.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall be effective on the first day of the month following approval.
