Consider rejecting all bids for Wi-Fi fiber access points cabinet connectivity project to complete

the southern loop of the City's wireless network for the MIT Department (Purchasing Office

Procurement Solicitation No. 2010-039)

<u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of this procurement was to have been the purchase of the labor, materials and means necessary to undertake and complete a Wi-Fi fiber access point cabinet connectivity project for the City of Franklin MIT Department in order to complete the southern loop of the City's wireless network.

Background

In fiscal year 2010, the MIT Department had intended for the City to outsource the work necessary complete the southern loop of the City's wireless network. Based in large part on an informal April, 2010 quote for the project obtained by the MIT Department, the City prepared and released specifications for the project which consisted of work at the following five (5) locations:

- Old Charlotte Pike East at New Highway 96 West
- 600 North Royal Oaks Parkway
- Oxford Glenn at McEwen Drive
- Noah Drive at Southeast Parkway
- Ralston Lane at Liberty Pike

Financial Impact

The City published on June 10, 2010 a Notice to Bidders in the *Williamson Herald* for Wi-Fi fiber access point cabinet connectivity. In addition, bid documents were sent on or about the same date directly to two (2) potential bidders known or thought to be interested in this solicitation. Bids from two (2) vendors were publicly opened at the bid opening held on June 24, 2010. A tabulation of the bids received for this solicitation is attached.

Options

In accordance with the bid documents, the City reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City reject all bids for the specified project. The MIT Department proposes to pursue undertaking this project using City staff and a combination of City-owned and City-rented or leased equipment. Purchasing Manager Brian Wilcox is of the opinion that the prepared specifications as distributed allowed for competition among multiple vendors, but that the staff recommendation to reject all bids appears to be made in a fair and impartial manner based upon the bids received.
