**SUBJECT:** Consideration of rejection of all bids for purchase of vehicular traffic data collection contract

services for the Traffic Operations Center Division of the Engineering Department (Purchasing

Office Procurement Solicitation No. 2011-003)

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this procurement is to purchase vehicular traffic annual data collection contract services for fiscal year 2011. Each year, the City's Traffic Operations Center collects peak hour turning movement counts for about one-third of the City's signalized intersections plus bi-directional average daily totals (ADT) counts at various locations. This data is used to adjust traffic signal timing.

### **Background**

In a memo dated September 20, 2010, staff recommended that the City accept the apparent lowest best bid, from National Data & Surveying Services, Inc. of Beverly Hills, CA, in the amount of \$14,650, for the specified vehicular traffic data collection contract services. The Engineering Department Traffic Operations Division budget for fiscal year 2011 allocates \$20,000.00 out of the General Fund for the purchase of traffic data collection contract services. The specified scope of work this fiscal year includes peak hour turning movement counts for thirty-one (31) signalized intersections and 24-hour bi-directional ADT (tube) counts at five (5) mid-block locations.

The Engineering Department has now determined that the City would very likely be able to save money in the future by using this year's budget to purchase data collection devices that would permit the City to video signalized intersections and mid-block locations as the means to collect traffic volume data instead of capturing the data by the visual and mechanical means originally specified. The video would still require analysis in order for the data to be transcribed into a usable format, and the City would still expect to outsource that process. Depending upon estimates for purchase of the data collection devices and for the transcription services, either quotes or sealed bids would be solicited.

### **Financial Impact**

Staff estimates that the City could purchase the necessary data collection devices and have this year's data transcription work performed within the amount budgeted in FY 2011 for data collection and transcription services. For as long as the data collection devices remain functional, only the transcription services would be required in subsequent years.

#### **Options**

- 1. In accordance with the bid documents, the City reserves the right to reject any and all bids. If this option is pursued, staff would solicit quotes or sealed bids for purchase of traffic volume data collection devices and for traffic volume data transcription services.
- 2. The City could accept the apparent lowest best bid, from National Data & Surveying Services, Inc. of Beverly Hills, CA, in the amount of \$14,650.00, for the scope of work originally specified.

#### Recommendation

Rejection of any and all bids is recommended.
