Afternoon Parking Lot Crash Leads to Columbia Woman's 4th DUI Arrest

Drive Drunk, Get Nailed

Franklin, TN – Franklin Police arrested 33-year-old Casey Gray of Columbia Monday afternoon for her fourth DUI after she struck a parked car. At 4:59 pm, officers were dispatched to the Independence Square Shopping Center, 595 Hillsboro Road, after a witness reported seeing Gray strike a car in the parking lot. When officers arrived, they found Gray asleep behind the wheel in a parking space near the unoccupied vehicle she struck. Officers determined that Gray was under the influence and arrested her.

Gray is free on a \$4,500 bond, charged with DUI – 4^{th} Offense, Violation of the Implied Consent Law, and Failure to Give Immediate Notice Following a Crash. She is due in court on 03/24/2011 at 2:00 pm.

"Drinking and driving needlessly puts innocent lives in danger," said Interim Chief of Police David Rahinsky. "If you are caught driving under the influence in Franklin, you will be arrested; you will go to jail."
