SUBJECT: Consideration of contract award to FastTek Electrocoating of Trufant, Michigan in the total amount of \$24,996 for electrostatic painting of traffic signal poles and mast arms at six (6) locations for the Traffic Division of the Streets Department (Purchasing Office Procurement Solicitation No. 2011-026; \$25,000.00 budgeted in 110-89470-43110 for fiscal year 2011)

Purpose

The purpose of this procurement is to have the traffic signal poles and mast arms at the following six (6) locations be repainted:

Background

The Streets Department Traffic Division budget for fiscal year 2011 allocates \$25,000.00 out of the General Fund for traffic signal pole painting.



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Financial Impact

The City published on March 10, 2011 a Notice to Bidders in the *Williamson Herald* for electrostatic painting of traffic signal poles and mast arms. In addition, bid documents were sent on or about the same date directly to seven (7) potential bidders known or thought to be interested in this solicitation. Bids from two (2) vendors were publicly opened at the bid opening held on March 24, 2011. A tabulation of the bids received for this solicitation is attached. The apparent lowest, most responsive and responsible bid, from FastTek Electrocoating of Trufant, Michigan, is in the total amount of \$24,996.00 for the specified project. This bid was identified because it is the lowest bid that meets or exceeds the City's intention as expressed and implied by the City's specifications as well as the instructions, terms and conditions pertaining to this procurement solicitation. The apparent lowest best bid amount is \$4 (0.00016%) under budget.

Options

In accordance with the bid documents, the City reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City accept the apparent lowest best bid, from FastTek Electrocoating of Trufant, Michigan, in the total amount of \$24,996.00 for the specified project. Purchasing Manager Brian Wilcox is of the opinion that the prepared specifications as distributed allowed for competition among multiple vendors, and that the staff recommendation appears to be made in a fair and impartial manner based upon the bids received.
