A RESOLUTION TO CREATE A RETIREE HEALTH INSURANCE TRUST

WHEREAS, the Government Accounting Standards Board has established requirements for the reporting of Other Post-Retirement Benefits (OPEB) for local governments; and

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee has adopted Chapter Number 771 of the General Assembly, the "Other Post Employment Benefit Investment Trust Act of 2006", allowing local government entities to establish an investment trust to finance OPEB: and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin wishes to take advantage of the Act passed by the Legislature to begin funding previously established for City; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board that the trust will be funded on an annual basis by contributions, similar to the annual pension plan contributions.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN:

- That an OPEB trust is hereby created.
- 2. That the previously created City of Franklin Pension Committee be the trustee of the plan.
- 3. That the Pension Committee establish an investment policy for the OPEB trust or adopt and apply the existing City of Franklin Pension investment policy to the trust.
- 4. That the actuarial firm engaged by the Pension Committee to conduct studies of the Pension Plan be engaged to study and report the liabilities and contributions of the OPEB Trust.

5. That the amount of contribution be changed from time to time to reflect any changes made by the Board to the OPEB benefits and to reflect the funding requirements determined by the actuary.
