SUBJECT: Consideration of bid award to Tom Bannen Chevrolet, Inc. of Madison, TN in the total amount of

\$27,834.90 for a quantity of one (1) two-door one-ton flatbed truck with gasoline engine for the Streets Department (Purchasing Office Procurement Solicitation No. 2012-018; \$33,000 budgeted

in 110-89520-43100 for fiscal year 2012)

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this procurement is to purchase a quantity of one (1) four-wheel-drive two-door one-ton flatbed truck with gasoline engine for the Streets Department Maintenance Division. This new truck is intended to be used by the paving crew to pull heavier equipment to job sites, and would be an expansion to the Streets Department's fleet of vehicles.

### **Background**

The City published on November 17, 2011 a Notice to Bidders in the *Williamson Herald* for a minimum of one (1) new one-ton pickup truck, and a minimum of one (1) new one-ton flatbed truck. In addition, bid documents were sent on or about the same date directly to ten (10) potential bidders known or thought to be interested in this solicitation. Bids from three (3) vendors were publicly opened at the bid opening held on November 29, 2011. A tabulation of the bids received for this solicitation is attached.

#### Financial Impact

The apparent lowest, most responsive and responsible bid, from Tom Bannen Chevrolet, Inc. of Madison, TN, is in the total amount of \$27,834.90 for a quantity of one (1) two-door one-ton flatbed truck with gasoline engine. This bid was identified because it is the lowest bid. All three (3) bids were found to take the same number of exceptions to the City's specifications. The Streets Department Maintenance Division budget for fiscal year 2012 allocates \$33,000.00 out of the General Fund for the purchase of a one-ton flat-bed truck. The Tom Bannen Chevrolet bid amount is \$5,165.10 (15.6%) under budget.

#### **Options**

In accordance with the bid documents, the City reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

#### Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City accept the apparent lowest best bid, from Tom Bannen Chevrolet, Inc. of Madison, TN, in the total amount of \$27,834.90 for a quantity of one (1) two-door one-ton flatbed truck with gasoline engine. Purchasing Manager Brian Wilcox is of the opinion that the prepared specifications as distributed allowed for competition among multiple vendors, and that the staff recommendation appears to be made in a fair and impartial manner based upon the bids received.
